## COMPLAINT

**Count I. Sodomy Or Attempted Sodomy - 1st Degree - Victim Is Less Than 12 Years  
Old (566.060-003Y20131199.0)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.060, RSMo, committed the felony of sodomy in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.060, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about July 23, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of the defendnat knowingly had deviate sexual intercourse with [REDACTED], a child less than twelve years of age who was incapable of consent because of youth and was manifestly unable and known by defendant to be unable to make a reasonable judgment as to the nature or harmfulness of the deviate sexual intercourse, by touching the defendnat's hand to [REDACTED]'s genitals.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense is required to be sentenced to life imprisonment without eligibility for probation and parole until the defendant has served thirty years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

## PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

Date: 7/25/2018

I, E. Knox, a Detective with the Independence, Missouri, Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 7/23/2018, at 2100 hours, Sean V. Fye, (Race- White, Sex- Male, DOB- 07-17-1997, Address-17006 E. Dover Lane, Independence, Missouri, [REDACTED], committed one or more criminal offenses in Jackson County, Missouri.

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 07-24-18 at 1041 hours, Officer Warren was dispatched to 1404 N. Holder, Independence, Missouri on a reported sex offense that had occurred at 1011 Concord Circle, Independence, Jackson County, Missouri. Dispatch advised the calling party was a social worker, Jessica Calvert, with Children's Mercy Hospital and she had reported a one year old child had received tears in her vagina and was seen at Children's Mercy Hospital last night.

Officer Warren made contact at the residence with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed him that the incident involved her [REDACTED] and her [REDACTED], the victim, [REDACTED] (DOB 06-17-17).

Officer Warren spoke with [REDACTED], who stated she was at her boyfriend, the Defendant, Sean Fye's house, located at 1011 Concord Circle with the Victim. She stated around 2100 hours, while changing [REDACTED]'s diaper she noticed [REDACTED] bleeding from her vaginal area and had to use a baby wipe to stop the area from bleeding. She stated she could not see an injury and it appeared that the bleeding was coming from inside the vagina. She called [REDACTED] for transportation to Children's Mercy Hospital. [REDACTED] stated after an examination she was told that the Victim had a tear to her Hymen tissue.

On 07-25-18, Detective Knox spoke with Jessica Calvert, the social worker from Children's Mercy Hospital. Jessica stated the victim had "blunt force penetrating injury of the hymen and an acute laceration of the hymen". Jessica stated the Defendant, Sean Fye/Frye was present at the hospital and stated while he was changing the Victim's diaper around 2145 hours, the Victim was squirming and he may have "clipped" the Victim's vagina with his fingernail causing the injury. Jessica stated the Victim's injury was at the five o'clock position and she had bloody mucus on her right interior of her buttock and dried blood during the exam which meant the injury was fairly recent.

Detective Knox issued a persons of interest card for Sean Fye on 07-25-18. Officer Youtsey arrested Sean Fye on 07-25-18.

Detective Knox and Detective Minter interviewed Sean Fye after advising him of his Miranda Rights. Sean advised while changing the Victim's diaper he inserted his right index and middle fingers into her vagina and hooked his fingers once they were inserted all the way to his knuckles. He stated he inserted the fingers out of curiosity but had a semi erection after he

removed his fingers. He originally made a statement saying he was using a wipe to clean the feces out of the Victim's vagina but later recanted and stated he did not use a wipe when he inserted his fingers.
