The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

Date: 11/16/2015

On 08/30/2015 at approximately 0620 hours, Police Officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were dispatched to the area of 3425 Park, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a Shot spotter, shots fired call. Upon arrival the officers discovered Victim #1, Victim #2 and Victim #3 had all been wounded from apparent gunshots. Victim #2 was attempting to render medical aid to Victim #1 who was pronounced deceased at the scene. The responding officers observed numerous spent shell casings strewn around the porch. In the street just south of 3421 Park Ave, seventeen 7.62 X39 spent shell casings were located. Just to the north of 3421 Park Ave in the street a WIN 9mm Lugar spent shell casing was located. On the sidewalk two Blazer 9mm spent shell casings were located. In the middle of the street in front of 3421 Park, Officers observed a silver driver's side mirror.

Victim #4 stated she was in the living room and shots were fired into the residence. Victim #4 looked out the window and observed a silver Chevrolet Impala. Victim #4 observed Joshua Randolph and Dahron Randolph both shooting towards the house. Victim #4 positively identifies Joshua Randolph and Dahron Randolph in a photo lineup. Victim #4 took Officers to 4319 Bales and advised 4319 Bales Ave is an address Joshua Randolph and Dahron Randolph are known to frequent.

Victim #2 stated he had just laid down to go to bed when he heard gunshots coming into the house. Victim #1 had a gun and fired back at the suspects who were shooting into the residence. Victim #2 went towards the front of the house and called 911. As he was waiting for the Police, two cars, a silver Pontiac and another vehicle drove southbound and begin firing into the house a second time. During the second drive by the three victims were struck with bullets. Victim #2 stated he recognized two people in the car and did not know their names. He knew them as "Rob Johnson's brothers."

During an area canvass a witness advised he heard gunshots and observed two silver vehicles traveling southbound in front of 3421 Park, one of them was possibly a Pontiac. The witness stated it appeared somebody was shooting from one of the vehicles. As they were traveling southbound the vehicles collided and a side view mirror fell off one of the vehicles.

Officers responded to 4319 Bales and located a silver Chevrolet Impala parked behind the residence. A search warrant was obtained and shell casings were located on the exterior of the vehicle below the windshield and sitting on the windshield wiper blade. The shell casings found on the Chevrolet Impala were the same caliber and head stamp as the shell casings found at 3421 Park Ave. Detectives spoke with the owner of the Chevrolet Impala who identified herself as Joshua Randolph's girlfriend. She stated Joshua Randolph and her are the only two people who drive the Chevrolet Impala. Joshua's girlfriend stated the Chevrolet had not been driven since Friday on 08/28/15 at 1630 hours when she parked it in the front of her residence at 4319 Bales. Joshua's girlfriend could not explain how the car got moved to the back of 4319 Bales where it was discovered by Officers. Paperwork with the name Joshua Randolph was located inside the Chevrolet Impala

While Officers were searching for Dahron Randolph at his residence 3824 E 60 Te they located a silver 2008 Pontiac Grand Prix. Officers observed the driver's side mirror to be missing, similar to the one recovered at the scene. Officers contacted a female who identified herself as Dahron's current girlfriend. Dahron's girlfriend stated Dahron lives with her at 3824 E. 60 Ter. Dahron's girlfriend stated Dahron drove her 2008 Pontiac Grand Prix last night and brought it home damaged with the mirror missing. Dahron's girlfriend stated at first Dahron lied and stated he sideswiped a car. Dahron then admitted to her he struck Joshua's car. The mirror located at 3421 Park appeared to be the same color and type as Dahron's girlfriends 2008 Pontiac Grand Prix was missing.

Dahron's girlfriend stated on 08/30/2015 at 0400 hours she woke up and Dahron was gone with her car. On 08/30/2015 at 0730 hours she received a phone call from Dahron and he stated he wrecked her car. Dahron's girlfriend waited outside for Dahron until he got home and she saw the damaged mirror on her Pontiac Gand Prix.
