COMPLAINT

Count I. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y19840999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Angenette Hollins caused the death of Angenette Hollins by shooting her.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Murder in the Second Degree charged in

Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Murder in the Second Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count III. Burglary 1st Degree (569.160-001Y20172299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.160, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of burglary in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly entered unlawfully in an inhabitable structure, located at 6021 Laurel Avenue, Raytown, Missouri and possessed by purpose of committing a stealing therein, and while in such an inhabitable structure there was present in such an inhabitable structure.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count IV. Stealing - \$750 Or More (570.030-035Y20172399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.030, RSMo, committed the **class D felony of stealing**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant appropriated a white Chevrolet Traverse of the value of at least seven hundred fifty dollars, which property was in the possession of and defendant appropriated such property without the consent of and with the purpose to deprive thereof.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count V. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y19840999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Jarrin A Walton caused the death of Jarrin A Walton by shooting him.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count VI. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Murder in the Second Degree charged in Count V, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Murder in the Second Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count VII. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt - Serious Physical Injury Or Special Victim (565.050-001Y19841399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant shot at the victim and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the offense of assault in the first degree of

and in the course thereof inflicted serious physical injury on Kori M Weatherspoon.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count VIII. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count VII, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count IX. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt (565.050-002Y19791399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant discharged a firearm striking (DOB: 7/21/2014) and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the offense of assault in the first degree of (DOB: 7/21/2014), and was done for the purpose of committing such assault.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count X. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count IX, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count XI. Endangering The Welfare Of A Child Creating Substantial Risk- 1st Degree - 1st Offense - No Sexual Conduct (568.045-005Y20173899.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.045, RSMo, committed the **class D felony of endangering the welfare of a child in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly acted in a manner that created a substantial risk to the life and body of ______. (DOB 07/19/2017) a child less than seventeen years of age, by discharging a firearm in close proximity to the child.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count XII. Unlawful Use Of Weapon - Subsection 9 - Shoot At/from Motor Vehicle, At Person, Motor Vehicle Or Building (571.030-020Y20145213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.030, RSMo, committed the **class B Felony of unlawful use of a weapon**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 571.030.9, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, at 5720 Elm, in the

County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, knowingly discharged a firearm at a habitable structure, to wit: a home located at 5720 Elm, Raytown, Missouri.

Pursuant to Section 571.030.9, RSMo, for the first violation a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony; for any violation by a prior offender as defined in Section 558.016, RSMo, a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony without the possibility of parole, probation, or conditional release for a term of ten (10) years; and for any violation by a persistent offender as defined in Section 558.016, RSMo, a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony without the possibility of parole, probation, or conditional release.

Count XIII. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Unlawful Use of a Weapon charged in Count XII, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count XIV. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y19840999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Jason L Jones caused the death of Jason L Jones by shooting him.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count XV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Murder in the Second Degree charged in Count XIV, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Murder in the Second Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

Count XVI. Endangering The Welfare Of A Child Creating Substantial Risk- 1st Degree - 1st Offense - No Sexual Conduct (568.045-005Y20173899.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.045, RSMo, committed **the class D felony of endangering the welfare of a child in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly acted in a manner that created a substantial risk to the life and body of ______. (DOB 08/28/2010) a child less than seventeen years of age, by discharging a firearm in close proximity to the child.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime. (>=2017)

Count XVII. Unlawful Use Of Weapon - Subsection 9 - Shoot At/from Motor Vehicle, At Person, Motor Vehicle Or Building (571.030-020Y20145213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.030, RSMo, committed the **class B Felony of unlawful use of a weapon**, punishable upon conviction under Section571.030.9, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, at 11209 Eastern Ave, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, knowingly discharged a firearm at a habitable structure, to wit: a home located at 11209 Eastern Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri.

Pursuant to Section 571.030.9, RSMo, for the first violation a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony; for any violation by a prior offender as defined in Section 558.016, RSMo, a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony without the possibility of parole, probation, or conditional release for a term of ten (10) years; and for any violation by a persistent offender as defined in Section 558.016, RSMo, a person shall be sentenced to the maximum authorized term of imprisonment for a class B felony without the possibility of parole, probation, or conditional release.

Count XVIII. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed **the felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 7, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Unlawful Use of a Weapon charged in Count XVII, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

Data: 10/00/2010

On 10/07/2018 at 0924 hours, Officers of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were dispatched to 9017 Kentucky Ave, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported shooting. Witness #1 called 911 and reported to the 911 call taker that her daughter in-law had just been shot at 9017 Kentucky Ave by her son Issac Fisher B/M 03/16/1983. Detectives later interviewed Witness #1 who stated Issac Fisher arrived at 9017 Kentucky Ave. Witness#1 was in her bedroom and could hear her son Issac Fisher and the victim arguing. Witness #1 heard the victim state, "I didn't take your money." Witness #1 then heard 4-5 gunshots. Witness #1 came out of her room and observed the victim lying on the bathroom floor suffering from apparent gunshots wounds. Witness #1 observed her son Issac Fisher walking out of the bathroom holding a small black handgun. Witness #1 stated she was fearful Issac was going to shoot her and stated she was calling the Police. Issac then went down into the basement and exited the residence. Witness #1 stated she went downstairs and locked the basement door fearing Issac might return. Witness #1 then waited until the Police arrived on scene. Witness #1 stated she believed Issac Fisher and the victim probably arrived in a blue car which belonged to the victim. Witness #1 stated she assumed Issac left in the blue car but she was not for certain. A search warrant was obtained for 9017 Kentucky Ave. 4 spent shell casings and one live bullet were located in the bathroom where the deceased victim was believed to have been shot. The shell casings were all head stamped GFL .45 ACP. Witness #1 stated her son Issac Fisher goes by the nickname, "Big".

On 10/07/2018 at 1021 hours Officers of the Raytown MO Police Department were dispatched to 6021 Laurel Ave on a reported stolen auto. Upon arrival Officers located a blue 2007 Dodge Caliber parked in front of the address with keys still in the ignition and the engine running. The blue Dodge Caliber was registered to the deceased victim at 9017 Kentucky Ave. Officers contacted Witness #2 at 6021 Laurel Ave who stated she observed her fiancé's brother, Issac Fisher come over to the residence and kick in the front door at 6021 Laurel Ave. Issac Fisher took the keys to Witness #2's white Chevrolet Traverse and then stole the white Chevrolet Traverse.

Upon arrival Officers located deceased victim #2 inside 5720 Elm suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Victim #2 was reported to be a step-brother to Issac Fisher. Officers also contacted a female victim who had been shot, a four year old child .07/21/2014) who injured victims were transported to area hospitals. Inside 5720 Elm Officers located spent shell casings with the head stamp GFL .45 ACP and caliber 7.62 x 39. Outside 5720 Elm Officers located spent shell casings in the yard which were 7.62 x 39 caliber. Officers observed numerous impacts on the exterior of 5720 Elm. A neighbor was contacted who told Officers the suspect was seen leaving the residence carrying a rifle over his shoulder like a baseball bat. The suspect fled in a white Chevrolet Traverse. On 10/07/2018 at 1028 hours Officers of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were dispatched to 11209 Eastern Ave, Kansas City, Jackson County Missouri on a reported shooting. Upon arrival Officers located Victim #3 who was deceased and was reportedly a cousin to Issac Fisher. Witness #4 was contacted who stated prior to the shooting she had left the residence at 11209 Eastern Ave to go to the store. When she returned home she observed a broken window on the front of the residence. She also noted there were bullet holes to the front Witness #4 contacted Victim #3 who was still alive. Victim #3 told Witness #4 that "Big" was the person who shot him. "Big" was later identified as Issac Fisher. Officers conducted an area canvass searching for Issac Fisher and the white Chevrolet Traverse. Officers located the white Chevrolet Traverse at 11210 Oakland Ave which is just east and behind 11209 Eastern Ave where Victim #3 was found deceased. Officers located spent shell casings both inside and outside 11209 Eastern Ave with the head stamp GFL .45 ACP.
