COMPLAINT

Count II. Tampering With Physical Evidence In Felony Prosecution (575.100-001Y20175006.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 575.100, RSMo, committed the **Class E Felony of Tampering With Physical Evidence**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 16, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant suppressed or concealed a Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm firearm, with the purpose to impair its availability in the investigation of the shooting at 239 W. 47th Street, Kansas City, Missouri on October 16, 2018, an official investigation, and thereby impaired and obstructed the prosecution of

The range of punishment for a Class E Felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.
