COMPLAINT

Count II. Tampering With Physical Evidence In Felony Prosecution (575.100-001Y20175006.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 575.100, RSMo, committed the **Class E Felony of Tampering With Physical Evidence**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 16, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant suppressed or concealed a Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm firearm, with the purpose to impair its availability in the investigation of the shooting at 239 W. 47th Street, Kansas City, Missouri on October 16, 2018, an official investigation, and thereby impaired and obstructed the prosecution of [REDACTED] for the crime of Assault in the First Degree, a felony.

The range of punishment for a Class E Felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

State vs. Quinton Shelby

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

BM, 05/09/2000 committed one or more criminal offense(s). (Description of Identity)

Tampering with Evidence

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 10/16/2018 at 1147 hours, Officers were dispatched to 239 W 47th St, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to shots fired. Upon their arrival they located several spent 9mm shell casings with the head stamp, "FC" in front of the business. And several possibly involved parties running from the scene.


Detectives interviewed WIT4 who said he was walking in the area of 239 W 47th St with several parties one of which was, Quinton SHELBY, BM, 05/09/2000. One of the unknown parties in the group fired several shots at VIC's 3 and 4 and the entire group began running from the scene. WIT4 said the unknown suspect who fired the shots handed the gun to SHELBY who then hid it under some mulch in an alley near the area.

On 10/16/2018 at 1500 hours, SHELBY was transported to the 6th floor of police headquarters. SHELBY was read his Miranda waiver and agreed to provide a statement to Detectives. SHELBY said he was walking around the plaza with a group of friends when his friend named, [REDACTED] fired several shots at two unknown males. The group ran from the scene and [REDACTED] handed him the handgun which he (SHELBY) then hid in between two buildings in the area underneath some mulch. SHELBY then hid in a nearby parking garage until police detained him.

Detectives located a black Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm handgun (serial HTJ9311) where one of the suspect had ran in between two buildings under some mulch behind 707 W. 47th St. The handgun contained a magazine loaded 10 9mm rounds with the headstamp, "FC" which matched the shell casings recovered from the original crime scene. The handgun was reported stolen on 09/30/2018 out of Lee's Summit Missouri 18-8717.
