COMPLAINT

Count I. Statutory Rape Or Attempted Statutory Rape - 1st Degree - Person Less Than 12 Yoa (566.032-003Y20171116.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.032, RSMo, committed the felony of attempted statutory rape in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.032, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Sections 217.735 and 559.106, RSMo in that on or between January 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant placed his penis on the vagina of and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of attempting to have sexual intercourse with _______, a child less than twelve years old, and was done for the purpose of committing such offense.

The offense of statutory rape in the first degree or an attempt to commit statutory rape in the first degree is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five years, unless: (1) The offense is an aggravated sexual offense, or the victim is less than twelve years of age in which case the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than ten years. An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense when the victim is a child less than twelve years of age shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

Count II. Child Molestation - 1st Degree (566.067-001Y20173618.0)

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall serve his or her term of imprisonment without eligibility for probation, parole, or conditional release. The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count III. Child Molestation - 1st Degree (566.067-001Y20173618.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.067, RSMo, committed the class A felony of child molestation in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011, and 566.067, RSMo and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735 and Section 559.106, RSMo, in that on or between January 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of the defendant, subjected who was then less than twelve years old, to sexual contact by touching 's vagina with his hand, and defendant, during the course of such conduct, engaged in this offense with a person the defendant knew to be his descendant by blood or adoption.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall serve his or her term of imprisonment without eligibility for probation, parole, or conditional release. The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count IV. Furnishing Pornographic Material Or Attempt To Furnish To A Minor (573.040-002Y19873799.0)

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count V. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173806.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between February 4, 2018 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was eighteen years of age or older, and knowingly caused , a child less than eighteen years of age, to suffer physical injury as a result of abuse by having smoke methamphetamine.

Count VI. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173806.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between February 4, 2018 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was eighteen years of age or older, and knowingly caused a child less than eighteen years of age, to suffer physical injury as a result of abuse by having snort methamphetamine.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count VII. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173806.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011 in that on or between August 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was responsible for the care, custody and control of ______, a child less than eighteen years of age, and neglected ______ by failing to provide schooling to ______, and as a result defendant knowingly caused the child to suffer mental injury.

Count VIII. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173802.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between March 1, 2018 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was eighteen years of age or older, and knowingly caused , a child less than eighteen years of age, to suffer physical injury as a result of abuse by burning

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count IX. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child - Serious Emotional Or Physical Injury - No Sexual Contact (568.060-006Y20123802.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class B felony of abuse of a child, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between March 1, 2018 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly placed his penis on the vagina of while is the presence of the county of the defendant caused to suffer from serious emotional injury.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years. The defendant who is found guilty of the class B felony of abuse of a child shall serve his sentence without eligibility for probation, parole, or conditional release until the defendant has served no less than one year of such sentence, unless the person has previously been found guilty of a violation of this section or of a violation of the law of any other jurisdiction that prohibits the same or similar conduct or the injury inflicted on the child is a serious emotional injury or a serious physical injury, in which case abuse or neglect of a child is a class B felony, without eligibility for probation or parole until the defendant has served not less than five years of such sentence.

Count X. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173806.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011 in that on or between August 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was responsible for the care, custody and control of ______, a child less than eighteen years of age, and neglected ______. by failing to provide schooling to ______ and as a result defendant knowingly caused the child to suffer mental injury.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count XI. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child - Serious Emotional Or Physical Injury - No Sexual Contact (568.060-006Y20123802.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class B felony of abuse of a child, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between January 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly placed his penis on the vagina of in the presence of ., a child less than fourteen years old, and, in the course thereof, the defendant cause . to suffer from serious emotional injury.

The offense of abuse or neglect of a child in which the injury inflicted on the child is a serious emotional injury is class B felony, without eligibility for probation or parole until the defendant has served not less than five years of such sentence. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count XII. Furnishing Pornographic Material Or Attempt To Furnish To A Minor (573.040-002Y19873799.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 573.040, committed the class A misdemeanor of furnishing pornographic materials to minors, punishable upon conviction under Sections 573.040, 558.011 and 560.016, RSMo, in that on or between January 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, knowing its content and character, presented material pornographic for minors consisting a video of adults engaging in sexual intercourse, to a person under the age of eighteen years and known by the defendant to be a person under the age of eighteen years.

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count XIII. Endangering The Welfare Of A Child Creating Substantial Risk- 1st Degree - 1st Offense - No Sexual Conduct (568.045-005Y20173899.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.045, RSMo, committed the class D felony of endangering the welfare of a child in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between January 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly committed the offense of unlawful possession of methamphetamine at 2315 Guinotte Ave, the residence of a child less than seventeen years of age.

Count XIV. Attempted Statutory Rape-1st Degree (566.032-999Y19951116.1)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.030, RSMo, committed the felony of attempted statutory rape in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.032, RSMo, in that on or between April 5, 2001 and August 26, 2002, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, he defendant placed his penis on the vagina of _______ and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of attempting to have sexual intercourse with _______ a child less than twelve years old, and was done for the purpose of committing such offense.

1st Degree Statutory Rape Committed with Additional Aggravating Acts with More than One Victim or Victim was Less than 12 years old: The range of punishment for the unclassified felony of first degree statutory rape where the defendant is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for life or for a term of years not less than ten years.

Count XV. Child Molestation 1st Degree (566.067-003Y20003699.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.067, RSMo, committed the class B felony of child molestation in the first degree punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between April 5, 2001 and April 4, 2006, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant subjected who was then less than fourteen years old to sexual contact by placing his hand on 's vagina.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count XVI. Child Molestation 1st Degree (566.067-003Y20003699.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.067, RSMo, committed the class B felony of child molestation in the first degree punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or between April 5, 2001 and April 4, 2006, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant subjected who was then less than fourteen years old to sexual contact by placing his penis in seal's hand.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.



The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.045, RSMo, committed the class D felony of endangering the welfare of a child in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 1, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly acted in a manner that created a substantial risk to the life, body and health of ..., a child less than seventeen years of age, by committing the offense of unlawful possession of methamphetamine at 2315 Guinotte Ave the residence of a child less than seventeen years of age.

Count VI. Abuse Or Neglect Of A Child Under Section 568.060.5(1) - No Sexual Contact (568.060-002Y20173806.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 568.060, RSMo, committed the class D felony of abuse or neglect of a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011 in that on or between August 1, 2017 and April 14, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant was responsible for the care, custody and control of ..., a child less than eighteen years of age, and neglected ... by failing to provide schooling to ... and as a result defendant knowingly caused the child to suffer mental injury.

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.


