**AMENDED  
PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

I, Scott McKee, a Detective with the Independence, Missouri, Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 10/20/2018, at 1500 hours, Alexander Allen Lee Schrader, (Race- White, Sex- Male, DOB- 06/24/2001, Address-616 E. Angus Street, Independence, MO 64055, [REDACTED], committed one or more criminal offenses in Jackson County, Missouri.

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 10/20/2018 at approximately 1500 hours the victim, [REDACTED], was walking in the area of 616 E Angus with a group of friends when [REDACTED] was confronted by the Defendant and several of his friends. The Defendant produced what appeared to be a black in color semi-automatic handgun and placed the gun to [REDACTED]'s head while [REDACTED] was kneeling on the ground. A friend of the Defendant began punching [REDACTED] in the face multiple times. [REDACTED] did not fight back and pleaded for the friend to stop assaulting him. During the incident another friend of the Defendant began videoing the assault and posted the assault on social media. The victim suffered injuries due to the assault.

On 10/22/2018 at 2245 hours Independence MO Police Officer Rick Romero was dispatched to 207 E. Short on a past assault involving juveniles. Officer Romero arrived and made contact with the complainant [REDACTED] who advised her thirteen year old child, (Victim) [REDACTED] 04/22/2005 was physically assaulted on 10/20/2018 by two juvenile suspects. Ms. [REDACTED] advised the victim told her the victim was walking in the area of E. Angus Street and S. Pearl Street in Independence, MO when the victim was assaulted. She advised one of the suspects, who was also a juvenile, punched her child in the face several times, forced her child to her child's knees requesting her child kiss his feet. Ms. [REDACTED] said the other suspect DEFENDANT Alexander A. Schrader held a pistol to the victim's head. Officer Romero observed minor bruising to the victim's face and Ms. [REDACTED] refused medical treatment.

On 10/23/2018 Officer Jason Smith was dispatched to the Independence Missouri Police Department to contact complainant [REDACTED] who advised her son [REDACTED] had been assaulted on 10/20/2018. She advised that the assault was videoed and put on social media. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she reported the assault to the Independence Police on 10/22/2018. Ms. [REDACTED] said she has received additional information about the assault and now wants to pursue charges. Officer Smith obtained information from Ms. [REDACTED] in regards to the names of other subjects present during the assault. Ms. [REDACTED] provided the video of the assault that had been posted to social media to Officer Smith. The video obtained of the assault was placed into Police property as evidence. The victim stated money was taken from him during the assault.

The Defendant learned that the Police were looking for him in regards to the incident and turned himself in at the Independence MO Police Department. The Defendant was subsequently interviewed and confessed to assaulting the victim by placing a gun to the victim's head.

The juvenile that physically assaulted the victim and the juvenile that videotaped the assault were interviewed and later transported to Juvenile Detention for processing.
