COMPLAINT

Count I. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 31, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant either acting alone or purposefully in concert with others forcibly stole a wallet owned by [REDACTED], and in the course thereof defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about August 31, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count Two, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant

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committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count III. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 5, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant either acting alone purposefully in concert with others forcibly stole a 2015 Scion XB in the possession of [REDACTED], and in the course thereof defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count IV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 5, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count three, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant

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committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count V. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 6, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant either acting alone or purposefully in concert with others forcibly stole 2014 Scion XB in the possession of [REDACTED], and in the course thereof defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count VI. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 6, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count Five, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant

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committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count VII. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 9, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant either acting alone or purposefully in concert with others forcibly stole 2013 Scion in the possession of [REDACTED], and in the course thereof defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count VIII. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 9, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendantthe defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count Seven, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference,

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and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count IX. Attempted Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171299.1)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of attempted robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 13, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant either acting alone or purposefully in concert with others forcibly stole 2015 Scion XB in the possession of [REDACTED], and in the course thereof defendant displayed what appeared to be a dangerous instrument.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifth-teen (15) years.

Count X. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 13, 2018, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of attempted robbery in the first degree charged in Count Nine, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of attempted robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a dangerous instrument.

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The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

Armed Robbery

ACA

Stolen Auto

Between the dates of 08-01-2018 and 10-24-2018, the Kansas City Missouri Police Department Robbery Unit has been investigating several armed robberies involving Z-Trip taxi cabs and food delivery drivers. In each of the robberies, several black male suspects, who are armed with a gun or knife, order a taxi cab or food delivery and then rob the victims of their vehicles and personal items. Several of the Z-Trip taxi cabs had interior surveillance video which recorded the robberies inside the cabs.

On 08-31-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 2305 E. 37th Street, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported armed robbery (#18-067315). Upon arrival officers made contact with [REDACTED] (W/M 10-31-1978) who stated that he worked for Domino's Pizza and was making a delivery to the location. When he arrived at the location, four black male suspects approached [REDACTED] and robbed him while armed with a handgun. The suspect stole [REDACTED] wallet which contained his money.

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On 10-05-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 2028 Park Tower, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported armed robbery (#18-077001). Upon arrival officers made contact with [REDACTED] (B/M 11-16-159) who stated that he is a taxi driver for Blue Ten Ten (Z-Trip) and was dispatched to the residence to pick up a fare. While at the location he was approached by several black male suspects and observed that at least one of the suspects was armed with an assault rifle. The suspects forced [REDACTED] out of his blue 2015 Scion XB (MM2Z5B (MO), VIN# JTLZE4FE7FJ071027) at gun point and made [REDACTED] lay on the ground. The suspects all entered [REDACTED]'S vehicle and fled the scene in the vehicle. A short time after the robbery, officers located the stolen vehicle in the area of 23rd and Wheeling at which time the vehicle was recovered and the interior surveillance video was later recovered and reviewed by detectives. After reviewing the surveillance video, detectives identified [REDACTED] (B/M 04-14-2001), [REDACTED] (B/M 05-20-2001), [REDACTED] (B/M 07-02-2002), [REDACTED] (B/M 07-29-2003), [REDACTED] (B/M 09-15-2001) and **Larentez D. Gravely (B/M 08-20-1999)** as the suspects who occupied DN'S stolen vehicle during the robbery and observed **Gravely** pointing an assault rifle at [REDACTED] while he was laying on the ground.

During this investigation, Pritchard and Rollins, were interviewed by detectives on 10-10-2018 while they were in custody on an unrelated incident. During their interviews, both suspects admitted their part in the robbery and stated that **Gravely** was present during this robbery and was armed with an assault rifle.

On 10-06-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 30th and Monroe, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported armed robbery (#18-077304). Upon arrival, officers made contact with [REDACTED] (B/M 01-17-1986) who stated that he is a taxi driver for Z-trip and was dispatched to the area to pick up a fare. While at the location, [REDACTED] was approached by six black male suspects and observed that one of the suspects was armed with an assault rifle. The suspects demanded that [REDACTED] exit his silver 2014 Scion XB (SL9W4E (Missouri), VIN# JTLZE4FE8EJ056180) at which time all of the suspects entered DR'S vehicle and fled the area. On 10-20-2018, DR'S stolen vehicle was located in the area of 3627 Garfield and was occupied by [REDACTED], who was sleeping in the vehicle. Detectives processed the vehicle however the surveillance system that is located in the rear view mirror had been removed from the vehicle.

On 10-09-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 6822 Walrond Avenue on a reported armed robbery (#18-078141). Upon arrival, officers made contact with [REDACTED] (B/F 06-19-1990) who stated that she is a taxi driver for Z-trip and was dispatched to 4416 E. 26th Street, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri to pick up a fare. While at the location, [REDACTED] stated that three black male suspects approached her and she observed that one of the suspects was armed with a rifle or shotgun. The suspects demanded that [REDACTED] empty her pockets and exit her vehicle. WR exited her vehicle at which time the suspects entered her silver 2013 Scion (DP3M7H (Missouri), VIN# JTLZE4FE7DJ041510) and fled the location. [REDACTED] stated that her back pack which contained her wallet, IDs, social security card and EBT card was inside the vehicle when the suspects stole the vehicle. On 10-09-2018, [REDACTED] stolen vehicle was located in the area of 26th and Kensington unoccupied and was recovered.

On 10-10-2018, officers were dispatched to 4416 E. 26th Street on a reported trespassing call. Upon arrival officers were told that several people were trespassing inside the location which is an abandoned residence. Officers conducted a residence check at which time **Gravely**, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were located inside the residence and arrested. Officers performed a search of the residence and located an assault rifle on a bed in a

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rear bedroom as well as [REDACTED]'S stolen EBT card which was on the bedroom floor. As **Gravely** was being searched incident to arrest, he was found to be in possession of [REDACTED] social security card, which was in his pants pocket.

On 10-10-2018, detectives interviewed all of the suspects mentioned above who all denied involvement in the robbery. When **Gravely** was interviewed he admitted that he was in possession of [REDACTED] stolen property which he found on the floor. **Gravely** was charged for possessing stolen property and all of the other suspects were released pending further investigation.

On 10-13-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 68th and Askew Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported armed robbery (#18-80140). Upon arrival, officers contacted [REDACTED] (W/F 08-18-1979) who stated that she is a taxi driver for Z-trip and was dispatched to 3801 Paseo Blvd pick up a fare. While at the location, [REDACTED] picked up two black male suspects who requested to go to 68th and Askew, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. [REDACTED] drove the suspects to the location and when she stopped the vehicle to let the suspects out, one of the suspects put a large knife to [REDACTED]'S neck and demanded that she exit her silver 2015 Scion XB (HL7D7C (Missouri), VIN#JTLZE4FE6FJ069365). When the suspects exited the rear passenger seats of the vehicle to get into the driver's seat of the vehicle, [REDACTED] accelerated her vehicle away from the suspects and called the Police.

Detectives obtained a copy of the surveillance video from the interior surveillance system in [REDACTED]'S vehicle and observed the robbery incident. Detectives observed the suspect who was sitting behind [REDACTED] in the rear passenger seat to be wearing a half clown mask and he was the suspect who was armed with the knife.

On 10-16-2018, members of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 35th and Garfield Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a reported armed robbery (#18-80167). Upon arrival, officers contacted [REDACTED] (W/F 10-15-1989) who stated that she is a taxi driver for Z-trip and was dispatched to the area to pick up a fare. At the location [REDACTED] observed two black male suspects waving her down who [REDACTED] believed were her clients. When [REDACTED] stopped her vehicle, both suspects approached her vehicle at which time one suspect opened her driver's door and demanded that [REDACTED] exit her vehicle. While [REDACTED] was engaged with the first suspect at her door, [REDACTED] observed the second suspect open her passenger door and attempt to steal her purse which was on the seat. [REDACTED] struggled with the second suspect for control of her purse at which time [REDACTED] accelerated her vehicle to get away from the suspects. When [REDACTED] fled from the suspects, her black with pink case cell phone fell out of her purse and fell into the street. [REDACTED] observed the suspects walk into the middle of the street and steal her cell phone before fleeing the location.

On 10-16-2018, detectives issued stop orders for the mentioned suspects and on 10-23-2018, **Gravely** was located and arrested for his stop order.

On 10-24-2018, detectives interviewed **Gravely**, who after waiving his Miranda rights, was shown the surveillance video from the 2028 Park Tower robbery on 10-05-2018 (#18-77001). **Gravely** viewed the surveillance video and admitted that he was present during the robbery and was the suspect on the video pointing a rifle at the victim who was laying on the ground. **Gravely** was asked about all of the above mentioned robberies and admitted that he was present and an active participant in each of the robberies.

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Gravely stated that during the robbery at 4416 E. 26th Street (#18-078141) he stole the victim's social security card after committing the robbery because he did not want to leave any evidence inside the vehicle. This is the social security that **Gravely** was found to be in possession of when he was arrested at the location on 10-10-2018. **Gravely** stated that during the robbery on 10-13-2018 at 68th and Askew (#18-080140), he was the suspect who was wearing the clown mask and was armed with a large knife which he put to the neck of the victim.
