Count I. Attempted Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171212.1)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Class B felony of an attempt to commit the offense of robbery in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011 and 564.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 6, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant tried to gain entry to a 2003 gold Honda Accord, a vehicle operated by that he needed to take her vehicle and that he had a gun and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of robbery in the first degree, and was done for the purpose of committing such robbery in the first degree.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count II. Attempted Stealing - Motor Vehicle/watercraft/aircraft (570.030-038Y20172404.1)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.030, RSMo, committed the **class E felony of stealing**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002, 558.011 and 564.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 6th, 2019, in the County

of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant demanded that give him the vehicle she was operating, a 2006 silver Toyota Sienna, and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of stealing and was done for the purpose of committing such stealing.

The range of punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution.

Count III. Resisting/interfering With Arrest For A Felony (575.150-001Y20174801.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 575.150, RSMo, committed the **class E felony of resisting an arrest**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 6, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, Officer , a law enforcement officer, was making an arrest of defendant for attempted robbery in the first degree, and the defendant knew or reasonably should have known that the officer(s) was making an arrest, and, for the purpose of preventing the officer(s) from effecting the arrest, resisted the arrest of defendant by using or threatening the use of violence or physical force.

The range of punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

I have probable cause to believe that on 01/06/2019 , at 40 th St and Walnut Ave. in

b/m, 10/09/1986, committed one or more criminal offense(s).
The facts supporting this belief are as follows:
On 01/06/2019, at 0917 hours, Officers were dispatched on an Armed Robbery in progress. Upon arrival officers observed a male matching the description provided by dispatch. After a short foot pursuit ensued, the officers were taking the suspect into custody when the suspect started fighting with the officers and grabbed one of the officers' duty weapons. The second officer then fired two shots at the suspect striking him. Two Armed Robbery/Attempted Carjacking victims were identified and provided formal statements. Victim one responded to police headquarters and provided a formal statement. stated she was driving south on Walnut Ave when she observed an unknown black male, later identified as the SUSPECT (Bullock, James T. b/m, 10/09/1986) walking North towards her vehicle. Bullock held his hand out and remained in front of her vehicle causing her to stop. Bullock then demanded her vehicle. She locked the doors and began back away from Bullock. Bullock continued to follow her demanding her vehicle. He then made a statement to having kids in the vehicle, so he left and began to walk westbound. then got the attention of witness one a security guard for Midtown Baptist Temple, 3953 Walnut St. KC, MO 64111, who attempted to contact Bullock.
was located and responded to police headquarters to provide a formal statement. stated he was working as a Security Guard when he observed Bullock following heard say, "He is trying to break into cars" at which point attempted to contact Bullock . Bullock was fleeing the scene westbound when began to follow him. When got to the parking lot on the north east corner of 40 th St and Main he observed Bullock trying to get into a second vehicle, which was later determined to belong to victim two further stated he was in the parking lot and witnessed two officers attempting to take Bullock into custody. He said he saw Bullock grabbing one of the officers hand guns and he heard that officer say "He's going for my gun". He then saw the second officer fire two shots, striking Bullock .
responded to police headquarters to provide a formal statement. stated she was parking her vehicle at approximately 0915, in the parking lot on the north east corner of 40 th St and Main, when she observed Bullock walking from the south in front of her vehicle. Bullock told her he needed her vehicle to which she said "No" several times. She told him to leave and that she was calling 911. She picked up her phone to call 911, then

Bullock began to pull on her driver's side door attempting to gain access to her car. Bullock told he had a gun and needed her car. While was on the phone with 911, Bullock walked away from her vehicle. was contacted by who was on the phone with 911 also and then followed in the direction of the Bullock.
One of the responding officers, victim three (responded to police headquarters and provided a formal statement. Stated he and his partner were responding to an Armed Robbery in progress call when they observed Bullock, who matched the description of the suspect, near 39 th St and Baltimore Ave. Spartner, Officer/Suspect (respondence) exited the vehicle and attempted to approach Bullock. Bullock began to flee the scene, so initiated a foot pursuit. So got into the driver's seat of their police vehicle and drove south on Baltimore Ave. and into a parking lot to the north east of Baltimore and Westport Rd. Sobserved Bullock, so he stopped his patrol vehicle and exited in an attempt to take Bullock into custody. And approached Bullock, with their duty firearms pointed at Bullock. They gave verbal commands for Bullock to get on the ground, which Bullock refused. And holstered their duty weapons in an attempt take Bullock into custody. As they were taking Bullock into custody Bullock grabbed so duty weapon and attempted to take it out of his holster. Selled "Gun grab" and "He's got my gun", at which time saw re-draw his duty weapon. Attempted to separate from Bullock as fired two shots striking Bullock. Once Bullock was on the ground placed him into custody and began administering first aid to Bullock. Bullock was transported to an area hospital where he is being treated for his injuries and was unable to provide a statement.
