# COMPLAINT WARRANT REQUESTED

## Count I. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y19840903.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 6, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly or with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Rayford E Reed caused the death of Rayford E Reed by shooting him.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

## Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about October 6, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of

Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of murder in the second degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of murder in the second degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

the unknown black male. After several minutes heard a pop and saw the victim exit the house. The victim tried to get in his truck saying "I can't believe that motherfucker shot me". and then got to the victim and put him in their truck and left the area.
During the next of kin notification, the victim's mother witness #2 informed detectives she received two telephone calls from 816-726, one of which left a voicemail. She stated she recognized the voice on the voicemail as "Sleeze" or Sleezeball" whose real name is "Eric." She stated "Eric" (later determined to be Conaway, lives at one of her rentals with had heard that "Sleeze" and had moved out. She stated she had told the victim that he needed to get "Sleeze" out of their rental property. She stated she believes her son (victim) is on the voicemail "begging for his life."

The voicemail was recovered and transcribed as follows:

- VOICE 1: I fuck with you and I hate to do something have to do something to you (inaudible) nigga. I hate that (inaudible) end ...I know you a good nigga.
- VOICE 2: I was going to (inaudible).
- VOICE 1: You, you, you (inaudible). You did all that fronting yesterday.
- VOICE 2: Let me (Inaudible).
- VOICE 1: (Inaudible) like my time...this nigga getting ready to see (inaudible) towards me, when we was here all by our self. (Inaudible) didn't say two words about me (inaudible) about four weeks. He said, "I ain't going to have to put you out am I, Sleezy?" I said, "Damn! You didn't...All you got to do is got to ask me to leave nigga." And you know what the fuck I'mma do? I might run down the street or something nigga. You think I'm going to fuck up our business I ain't in your way nigga.
- VOICE 2: (Inaudible)
- VOICE 1: I ain't in your way, cuz. Why you ain't, why you ain't answering the phone? Give me that phone man. Hello? (2 loud pops). Fuck that phone.
- VOICE 2: (Inaudible) somebody please, please, pretty please Sleezy (2 quieter pops) pretty, pretty please. I'm begging you.
- VOICE 1: (Inaudible) I ain't no hoe ass nigga, dog. I ain't no hoe ass nigga.
- VOICE 2: You ain't got to do it though. (Inaudible)
- VOICE 1: Man I got to do all this. (Inaudible) my baby gone, nigga. (pop) Yo homeboy, (inaudible) back against the wall, cuz. (Inaudible) back against the wall cuz. Come on. Hey, hey, 'cuse me.
- VOICE ?: (Inaudible) bro.
- VOICE 1: Do you need me to call somebody?
- VOICE 1: We going to call your mama don't mean you did it though. Huh?
- VOICE 2: 913-605 (Inaudible).
- VOICE 1: Huh? (inaudible) dial with (inaudible), dial it nigga, dial it nigga, because you didn't dial it.
- VOICE 2: I did dial it!
- VOICE 1: You didn't dial it.
- VOICE 2: (Inaudible)
- VOICE 1: You dialed my serve nigga.
- VOICE 2: That's not your serve (Inaudible) that's my momma's number bro.

On 02-27-202 Miranda Waiv	20 Conway was taken into custody. At 1045 hours he was advised of his Miranda Rights via the ver.
tated that he later in the control of the control o	ted that he had assisted his girlfriend in moving out of the house she rented from the victim and had previously stayed in the house with her. <b>Conaway</b> denied having any conversations with the day of the homicide. <b>Conaway</b> admitted that people call him, "Sleeze," or, "Sleezeball," but stated ot respond to it.
