COMPLAINT WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y19840912.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about April 25, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly or with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Larry A. Green caused the death of Larry A. Green by driving over him with a motor vehicle.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment. An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo,

committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about April 25, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Murder in the Second Degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporate herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Murder in the Second Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a dangerous instrument, to wit a motor vehicle.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count III. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt - Serious Physical Injury Or Special Victim (565.050-001Y19841305.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about April 25, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant struck with a motor vehicle, and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the offense of assault in the first degree of assault, and in the course thereof inflicted serious physical injury on

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment. The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment. An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

Count IV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about April 25, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count III, all allegations of which are incorporate herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a dangerous instrument, to wit a motor vehicle.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

observed Waloke drive away but then return to the area where she exited the vehicle and verbally threatened to kill and other bystanders if they called the police. To observed the run across the street into a yard where Wolke hit her with the car. To got up and ran to the porch as Waloke drove at the crashing into the porch. The porch and around the house to get away as the suspect attempted to drive the car around the residence. The saw the suspect come driving around the house and through the yard where it crashed and was disabled. The stated Waloke returned to the car and retrieved an unknown item and started to run away from the scene because she observed the police coming up the street. The stated he pointed the police in the direction Waloke was running and observed the police take her to the ground and arrest her. Waloke is the same female suspect who ran over the victim multiple times.
I contacted who stated the following: He is house sitting at 3007 York Street and heard fighting outside. He observed the bind the west side of York Street south of E. 30 th Street. Was running towards his house "in fear" as the black Cadillac chased her. The Cadillac chased her. The Cadillac struck the porch causing damage, drove through the yard and became disabled across the street. He saw a black female exit the vehicle and flee north on York Street then west on E. 30 th Street.
I contacted who was staying at 3000 York Street. He heard fighting outside and opened the door. He observed a black female (Waloke) and black male (Green) fighting in the yard; the black Cadillac was parked facing east on E. 30 th Street. As Waloke and Green were fighting, Waloke was shouting Green was raping her. A large passenger van pulled up and 2 males and 2 females exited the van. The females rummaged through the Cadillac, one male appeared to be looking out as the second male began striking Green. The two unknown black males and two unknown black females re-entered the van and left the scene. Green got up and appeared to try and walk to the east. Waloke entered the Cadillac and chased Green down striking him. She repeatedly put the car in drive and reverse driving over Green at least 4 times. Patterson stated the last time he believes the Cadillac got stuck as the tires were squealing and the vehicle wasn't moving. Waloke then exited the Cadillac and began shouting at bystanders. Patterson observed a white female on the east side of York, south of 30 th Street on the phone telling Waloke she was wrong for what she did and the police had been called. Waloke then drove through the yard at 3000 York towards that female striking her with the Cadillac. Waloke then drove through the yard at 3000 York towards that female are a around the back of 3007 York with the Cadillac still chasing. The Cadillac struck the porch and crossed the street becoming disabled. Was unsure of Waloke's actions after the crash as he walked away from the scene to the park.
Sgt. J. Pickens and Sgt. J. Rivers were two of the initial officers on scene. Sgt. J. Pickens placed Waloke under arrest west of York Street on E. 30 th Street under the direction of bystanders as she was running from the scene. Waloke was in possession of the key fob for the Cadillac as well as Farmers Insurance papers for Larry Green. The black 2013 Cadillac bearing Missouri license LGREEN is registered to Larry Green.
Waloke appeared impaired as she was unresponsive to pressure point, pain compliance, sternum rubs and joint locks; she was mumbling incoherently. Waloke is currently located at North Kansas City Hospital where she was transported for an evaluation. Officer D. Davidson obtained a search warrant for samples of Walokes blood and obtained 4 vials of blood. Results of those tests are pending.
