Count I. Burglary - 2nd Degree (569.170-001Y20172203.0)

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 05-30-2020 at approximately 11:00 pm Det. Richter of the Metro Property Crimes Section, while working a large protest in the Plaza area of Kansas City, Missouri was notified of a possible burglary/looting incident at The North Face located at 312 W. 47th Street, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. Det. Richter along with several other Kansas City Missouri Police Officers went to the location. As they were approaching from the south on Central they observed a black male and a black female walking southbound on Central from 47th Street. The black male and black female both dropped the clothing they were carrying. The black male ran westbound on 47th Street and was not arrested. The female remained at the location and was taken into custody. The property dropped by the female included an Apex Bionic Jacket (\$596), North Face M TBall ECG sweater (\$660) and a North Face M 9SRTO Denali Jacket (\$199). Det. Richter photographed the scene and uploaded it to the report. The front window of the store was broken out and there were clothing items strewn about inside. The property outside the store was photographed and placed back in the store.

On 05-31-2020 at 11:27 am Det. Mountz of the Central Property Crimes Section responded to the Shoal Creek Patrol Division Detention Unit and escorted the suspect in this case to an interview room. She was asked if she was aware of the purpose for her arrest was and she stated that she did. She was then advised of her rights verbally by Det. Mountz utilizing the Miranda Warning and Waiver Form 340 PD. She waived her rights agreeing to talk about the case. She did not sign the form due to the COVID-19 virus. She stated that she was going to a friend's and got a call to meet some other friends on the Plaza. She was walking back to her car around 10:00 pm when she saw a bunch of people coming out of the Northface store. One of them threw some clothes when the police showed up. She stated that the police chased after one guy but couldn't catch him. She dropped the clothes she had and then the police arrested her. She was asked to explain where she got the clothes she was carrying. At this time she stated she thought she should have a lawyer. She did not have the name of her attorney, but stated she knew one that did traffic stuff. She was returned to the detention unit at this time.

The interview was video recorded as evidence.
