On 10/23/2019 at approximately 2257 hours P.O. Garth and Gonzalez (R#136) conducted an area canvass for the Toyota Rav4 which was thought to have been taken by the suspect. Officers then observed a half red and white Chevrolet Camaro driving North Bound on Southwest Trafficway from Westport Rd.	
Later when the officers contacted , she stated that <b>WATTS</b> owned several vehicles one of which is a half red and white Chevrolet Camaro. The vehicle description provided matched the vehicle P.O. Gonzalez observed at approximately 2300 hours. After further investigation the half red and white Chevrolet Camaro (License# HIOFECR out of GA) was captured on an automatic license plate reader driving east bound on I-670 Hwy at approximately 2313 hours. Officers contacted the Missouri Information Analysis Center and were advised that the listed half red and white Chevrolet Camaro did belong to <b>WATTS</b> .	
On 10/24/2019 at 1022 hours, the Detective obtained a statement from Watts's previous employer, Anthony PRICE, who stated that he had received several calls from Watts after the time of the shooting. During his statement Price stated the following:	
Wednesday 10/23/2019 he had received a phone call from WATTS. When he answered the phone WATTS sounded upset, when he asked WATTS what was going on. WATTS stated "I can't work for you any more", WATTS said "I fucked up real bad I shot when he asked WATTS what he was talking about WATTS said "I shot two times". WATTS stated that 's landlord had been trying to call him, and was yelling at him for shooting. He could barely understand WATTS, because WATTS was "jumping around" so much in the conversation. He asked WATTS where he was and WATTS said he was an hour from his brother's house in Georgia. Then WATTS would say that he was three hours from home and would be back in Michigan soon. In a later phone call with WATTS, WATTS stated he believed he had not shot the victim and stated all of the bullets were still in his gun.	
Price stated he fears <b>WATTS</b> and what he might do. Price has closed his business temporarily until <b>WATTS</b> is arrested in efforts to protect his employees.	
On October 23, 2019, detectives executed a search warrant of search covered in blood. A comforter and sweater were found on the sofa also with blood. On October 24, 2019, a second search warrant was executed on search covered in blood. Search for her cell phone (816-830-3737). The phone was not found in residence or located on her person when she was transported to the hospital.	
is currently in critical condition with two gunshot wounds to the head, a bullet lodged behind her right eye, and bullet fragments in her stomach. WATTS lives in Michigan and has no known ties to the Kansas City area. Due to the violent nature of the assault and the significant injuries that the victim sustained in the assault, I am asking for the consideration of a warrant, and that a bond be associated to that warrant.
