Fatality Crash

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 12-28-2019 at 1036 hours, Officer C. Spencer responded to E. 18th Street and Indiana Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to an injury crash. Upon arrival, Officer C. Spencer contacted driver #2 (victim) Ventura Gonzalez. Mr. Gonzalez advised he was traveling southbound on Indiana Avenue when a vehicle traveling northbound drove into his lane of travel and struck his vehicle head on. Mr. Gonzalez stated his friend; Rob Heslop (deceased victim) was riding in the front passenger seat of his vehicle. Mr. Gonzalez described his vehicle as a maroon Ford F-150 pick-up. Mr. Heslop was unconscious at the crash scene and he was unable to give a statement. Driver #1, TONYA L. ROLF (aka Tonya Brown) B/F 09-04-1967, was transported to an area hospital prior to Officer C. Spencer's arrival at the crash scene. Mr. Gonzalez was also transported to an area hospital for treatment.

Officer C. Spencer responded to the hospital in attempt to get a statement from driver #1, TONYA L. ROLF, but she was unable to give a statement due to her being unconscious.

Vehicle #2's front seat passenger, Rob Heslop was transported to an area hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.

I later contacted driver #2, Ventura Gonzalez. Mr. Gonzalez stated he sustained an open wound fracture to his right ankle and some torn ligaments in his left knee, a torn rotator cup in left shoulder, two broken ribs and a concussion. Mr. Gonzalez stated ROLF drove into in his lane of travel and struck him nearly head on. Mr. Gonzalez stated he was driving southbound and ROLF was driving northbound. Mr. Gonzalez gave consent to the release of his medical record and he provided me a copy of his hospital records.

I later contacted driver #1, TONYA L. ROLF. ROLF stated she didn't know how the crash happened. ROLF remembered driving her Ford Explorer to Price Chopper at 5800 Wilson Road. ROLF consented to providing her medical records. ROLF stated she was treated and released from the hospital.

A review of ROLF'S medical records revealed she tested positive for high levels of Benzoylcegonine and Alcohol, Serum with a **BAC of .292**.

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A computer check of ROLF revealed her to be valid through Missouri DOR.
