The Children's Place is Kansas City's specialized trauma treatment center serving the mental health needs of young children since 1978.

Our four core programs are Assessments ई Screenings, Counseling Center, Family Support Services and Day Treatment.

Children in both the Day Treatment and Outpatient Counseling programs have experienced an average of five traumatic events.

Highest percentages of shared traumatic events are separation from parents, parent or relative in prison, neglect, caregiver's substance abuse, family member's mental illness and domestic violence.

The average time for a child in the Day Treatment program is 15 months. All children (one to five years old) receive mental health, occupational, speech and language and group therapies along with early childhood education.

The average time for a child to receive therapy from outpatient Counseling Center is 9 to 12 months with an average of 20 sessions during that timeframe. We serve children up to the age of 8 in this program.

Each year our diagnostic team offers developmental screenings for approximately 350 children, ages six weeks to six years old, who are in state custody or who may be at risk for developmental delays. These screenings provide an overview of a child's developmental abilities to gauge whether treatment is recommended at The Children's Place or one of our community partners.

Family Support Services helps caregivers learn parenting skills, including recognizing how the sad and scary events of the past may be impacting their child's behaviors through individual services and caregiver groups.

Traumatic events are similar to an ear infection—it hurts, and the sooner treatment is administered, the quicker the pain subsides and prevents longterm suffering and future complications.
