COMPLAINT
WARRANT REQUESTED

**Count I. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt - Serious Physical Injury Or Special Victim
(565.050-001Y20201399.0)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about May 28, 2022, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused serious physical injury to by shooting

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y20205299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section

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571.015.1, 571.015.2, and 571.015.3, RSMo, in that on or about May 28, 2022, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of assault in the first degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of assault in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The punishment imposed pursuant to Section 571.015, RSMo shall be in addition to and consecutive to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015.1, RSMo. is imprisonment by the department of corrections for a term of not less than three years and not to exceed fifteen years, unless the person is unlawfully possessing a firearm, in which case the term of imprisonment shall be for a term of not less than five years. No person convicted under this subsection shall be eligible for parole, probation, conditional release, or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015.2, RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment by the department of corrections for a term of not less than five years and not to exceed thirty years, unless the person is unlawfully possessing a firearm, in which case the term of imprisonment shall be for a term not less than fifteen years. No person convicted under this subsection shall be eligible for parole, probation, conditional release, or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015.3, RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 05/28/2022 at 1351 hours, officers with the Kansas City, MO Police Department were dispatched to the area of 2200 Cliff Dr, Kansas City, Jackson County, MO in regard to a shooting.

Upon their arrival they located the victim, [REDACTED], lying on the ground suffering from a gunshot wound to the lower back. [REDACTED] was transported to a local hospital where he was rushed into surgery in critical condition. Several witnesses were also located who provided a description of the suspect, notably, the suspect was a skinny black male wearing a yellow or blue shirt with possibly a yellow flower print, and baggy dark pants.

Officers moved into the area and Sgt. McCunniff with the Kansas City, MO Police Department located IGAL near Maple Boulevard and Lexington. IGAL is a skinny black male and he was wearing a dark colored shirt with a yellow flower print and blue design. As soon as IGAL observed the Sergeant he took off running into the park. The Sergeant observed that IGAL was armed with a pistol and immediately gave chase on foot. IGAL was given verbal directions to stop and drop the gun, which he complied with. IGAL was then taken into custody without incident. The gun found in IGAL'S possession was a Hi Point .380, Model CF380, Serial #P8095394, it was loaded with one round in the chamber and five live rounds in the magazine.

When processing the scene where the shooting occurred detectives were not able to locate spent shell casings due to the long grass.

Four witnesses were identified and transported to Kansas City Police Headquarters to provide recorded statements.

[REDACTED] stated he was playing in a Frisbee Golf Tournament and he was in a group with the victim and two other witnesses, [REDACTED] stated when he arrived he noticed IGAL walking around the thought he was "Up to

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something". The group went on to begin their round and as they were walking along the first hole IGAL walked up to them, produced a pistol and shot [REDACTED]. IGAL then fired several more rounds. [REDACTED] then observed IGAL run to the south towards the park gate. [REDACTED] was shown a photo line-up with six black males of similar appearance. [REDACTED] positively identified photo #2 as the shooter. Photo #2 was a photo of IGAL.

[REDACTED] stated he was playing in a Frisbee Golf Tournament and he was in a group with [REDACTED]. He stated that prior to the tournament starting IGAL walked up to their group and began following them. After they threw their first shot and began walking to the hole IGAL followed them. As they were walking he heard [REDACTED] yell he's got a gun and he then heard 3-4 shots fired. [REDACTED] then observed the suspect run to the south. [REDACTED] was shown a photo line-up with six black males of similar appearance. [REDACTED] positively identified photo #2 as the shooter. Photo #2 was a photo of IGAL.

[REDACTED] stated he was playing in a Frisbee Golf Tournament and he was in a group with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated prior to the start of the tournament a black male later identified as IGAL walked up to their group and he appeared to be "out of sorts". [REDACTED] stated the tournament started and after they threw their first shots they were walking towards the hole, he observed IGAL to be walking behind them. He then heard someone yell about a gun and turned to see IGAL waving a gun around, IGAL then shot at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was shown a photo line-up with six black males of similar appearance. [REDACTED] positively identified photo #2 as the shooter. Photo #2 was a photo of IGAL.

[REDACTED] stated he was playing in a Frisbee Golf Tournament in Kessler Park. Prior to the tournament he observed a black male acting suspicious in the area. Just after the tournament started he heard several pops. He then looked to the area of the sounds and saw the same black male running to the south. [REDACTED] W. was shown a photo line-up with six black males of similar appearance. [REDACTED] picked out photo #3, which was a filler.

Due to the seriousness of [REDACTED]'s injuries he was not able to be interviewed. He is still listed in critical condition.

On 5/28/2022 at 1534 hours, detectives responded to Kansas City, MO Police Department's East Patrol Detention and checked to IGAL out to interview him. IGAL was read his Miranda Warning and agreed to speak to detectives. When asked about the shooting IGAL would not talk about it. He was checked back into detention at 1550 hours.

IGAL should be considered a serious danger to the public as he walked up to a group of individuals with whom he had no prior knowledge of and shot at them without warning from a close distance.
