Sexual Assault

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 09/02/2021, at about 2355 hours, Officers of the Kansas City Missouri Policed Department were dispatched to 9004 Indiana Ave, Kansas City, Jackson County, MO in regard to a Juvenile Rape. Upon arrival officers contacted [redacted], juvenile victim, who was observed to be wearing only a bra. [redacted] stated that the suspect, Bomani Madu, was getting her high and drunk. She was unable to provide any further statement do to vomiting. Officers than contacted [redacted], who stated the following: She got a call from one of her granddaughter's friends who told her that Bomani was raping [redacted]. She returned to the house and [redacted] came running out of the house completely naked. She sent her sister, [redacted], into the house to get [redacted] clothes to wear. [redacted] told her that Bomani ate her out vaginally and anally.

On 09/03/2021, [redacted] responded to the Child Protection Center to participate in a forensic interview. She disclosed Bomani gave her alcohol and marijuana. He showed her his erect penis while touching himself. He forced her to take off her shirt and bra. He rubbed and licked her breasts. He forced her to take off her pants and underwear. He used his tongue to lick inside and outside of her vagina and anus. When she told him no, he balled up his fists like he was going to punch her. She thought he was going to kill her.

[redacted] was transported from the scene to CMH via ambulance, and during the ambulance ride, she gave additional information. [redacted] stated the following: She was alone with [redacted] (Suspect), Bomani Madu, who gave her alcohol and marijuana, which was laced with something. She was in her bedroom when Bomani came in with his "thing" out. She yelled at him and he left. He came back in with his "thing" put away. He demanded that she take her clothes off, and when she said no, he raised his fist as if he was going to hit her. He pulled her shirt off over her head and began licking her nipples. She was on the phone with her friends so she yelled for help and to have someone call her grandmother. She further stated that Bomani licked her vagina and butt.

On 09/03/2021, [redacted] arrived at Children's Mercy Hospital, where she received a SAFE exam and was diagnosed with Concern for Child Sexual Abuse.

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On 09/03/2021, detectives responded to the scene to obtain a formal statement from [REDACTED] stated she got a phone call from a friend of [REDACTED], who told her that **Bomani** had gotten [REDACTED] high and was raping her. When she got home she observed **Bomani** coming out of [REDACTED] bedroom. She yelled for [REDACTED] who ran out of her bedroom wearing sweatpants and no shirt or bra. [REDACTED] told her that **Bomani** came into her room with his thing out. He was telling her to take her clothes off. He balled up his fist as if he was going to hit her. He ate her out and ate her butt.

On 09/03/2021, Detectives responded to Metro Patrol Detention to conduct a custodial interview with **Bomani**. **Bomani** was advised of his Miranda Rights, and declined to speak with detectives. **Bomani** did, however, give consent to allowing detectives to obtain a buccal swab of his DNA and signed a Consent to Search form in regard.
