COMPLAINT
WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. Assault - 3rd Degree - Special Victim (565.054-001Y20201399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.054, RSMo, committed the class D felony of assault in the third degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 5, 2024, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused physical injury to VICTIM 1, a law enforcement officer in the performance of his official duties and special victim, by choking him.

The range punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 02/05/2024 at 1130 hours officers with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department who are assigned to Southeast Highschool [REDACTED] as school resource officers observed an altercation between several students inside the school.

Officers responded and attempted to escort the student to the administration room. The student became combative and assaulted [REDACTED] by kicking him in his scrotum several times. While officers were on the ground attempting to place the student in handcuffs the SUS (LOWE, Tre'viar) put [REDACTED] in a headlock. LOWE was taken into custody and transported to Metro Patrol Detention.

WIT3 (Kansas City Public School Security) was interviewed and advised that there was an altercation between several girls inside the gym of the school. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] responded and separated the girls. [REDACTED] attempted to escort one of the female students to away from the altercation when she became combative and began mule kicking him in the scrotum several times. [REDACTED] took the female student down to the ground. While he and [REDACTED] were attempting to put handcuffs on the female student the SUS (LOWE) attempted to intervene with the arrest of the female student. WIT3 observed LOWE put [REDACTED] into a headlock for several seconds. Several officers came to [REDACTED]'s aid and LOWE was placed under arrest. WIT3 observed [REDACTED] to be in medical distress after the incident. WIT3 observed [REDACTED] vomit and have labored breathing.

WIT2 (Kansas City Public School Security) located at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] WIT2 stated on February 5, 2024, he was working in uniform at Southeast School. He stated he was notified by radio transmission there was something happening at the gym at approximately 1140 hours. WIT2 stated upon arriving at the gym he observed Kansas City Missouri Police School Resource [REDACTED] escorting female student out of the gym. He stated the female student was yelling and cussing. WIT2 stated he was asked to escort the female student to the Vice Principals office to talk about what was happening. He stated he tried to talk with female student to calm her down and get her to comply with responding to the Vice

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Principal's office but she continued refusing to comply. WIT2 stated [REDACTED] stepped in to escort the female student to the Vice Principals office, at which time, she mule kicked [REDACTED] twice in the scrotum and she kicked him once in the right knee. He stated [REDACTED] and WIT3 took the female student to ground. WIT2 stated LOWE responded and began yelling at everyone. He stated LOWE began choking [REDACTED] and trying to pull him away from the female student. WIT2 stated he was trying to get LOWE to release the hold and after approximately one minute he and WIT3 were able to pry away LOWE's grip from around [REDACTED]'s neck.

Detectives responded to [REDACTED] (Metro Patrol Detention) to interview LOWE. LOWE was escorted from detention to an interview room where he was read Miranda Warning. LOWE understood his rights and agreed to provide a statement. LOWE stated he is a student at Southeast Highschool. LOWE stated he was walking around the school looking for his girlfriend. LOWE stated as he was walking down a set of stairs, he could see a scuffle between his girlfriend and police officers. LOWE observed [REDACTED] slam his girlfriend down to the ground two separate times in the scuffle. LOWE stated he went to the aid of his girlfriend and placed [REDACTED] in a headlock. LOWE stated as he had [REDACTED] in a headlock a 2nd officer responded and attempted to pull him off of [REDACTED]. LOWE stated as the officer was pulling him away, he kept the headlock on [REDACTED]. LOWE stated he eventually let go of [REDACTED] and continued to resist due to him being upset and use of force used on his girlfriend. LOWE stated he did not want to hurt [REDACTED].

Surveillance cameras captured the incident inside the school. Surveillance cameras captured [REDACTED], WIT2 and WIT3 attempting to gain control of the female student. The surveillance footage shows LOWE place [REDACTED] in a headlock for approximately 10 seconds before officers and security could pull him away.

[REDACTED]'s body worn camera was reviewed and showed him in an altercation with a female student. [REDACTED] can be heard saying he was being kicked in the scrotum by the female student.

The female student was transported to the Jackson County Juvenile Center where she is currently being held.

[REDACTED] is a uniformed Kansas City Missouri Police officer assigned to Southeast Highschool.

[REDACTED] was transported to an area hospital treatment. [REDACTED] complained of a sore throat. Officers also noticed [REDACTED]'s voice becoming labored and raspy. Upon entering the area hospital, [REDACTED] lost consciousness. [REDACTED] had to be intubated and is currently in the ICU. Doctors advised [REDACTED] sustained some damage to his airway and that his airway was swelling.
