Count I. Assault 2nd Degree (565.060-001Y198413990)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, **Jestin L. Waterhouse**, in violation of Section 565.060, RSMo, committed the **Class C Felony of Assault in the Second Degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 1, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant recklessly caused serious physical injury to by failing to maintain the proper lane of traffic with the vehicle which the defendant was operating while was a passenger and thereby causing a collision with a utility pole and a building.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count II. Leaving Scene Of Motor Vehicle Accident - Injury, Property Damage Or 2nd Offense (577.060-001Y197954990)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, **Jestin L. Waterhouse**, in violation of Section 577.060, RSMo, committed the **Class D Felony of Leaving the Scene of a Motor Vehicle Accident**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 1, 2016, the defendant, while operating a motor vehicle on Independence Avenue, a highway, at or near Elmwood in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, was a party to an accident that caused another person to sustain physical injury, and the defendant knew that such injury had occurred, and the defendant left the scene of the accident without stopping and giving sufficient information by which the defendant could be readily identified and located to the nearest police station or judicial officer.
