On 04/01/2021 at approximately 0600 hours, woke up, took her money back and left the residence located at 521 E Winner Rd, without WALKER knowing. stated that when she took her money back, some of WALKER's money was mixed in with hers. Around 1100 hours, went to Metro PCS located at 2715 Van Brunt to get a new phone because she stated that WALKER had stolen all of her personal data. While she was outside talking with the older model four door vehicle with who was driving and was driving and was the rear passenger. WALKER got out of the vehicle, pointed a black handgun at chest and demanded her to get into the vehicle. Initially, told WALKER no and refused to get into the vehicle.
