She did not see Maiden leave the home and notified police of this fact when they arrived.

During the course of the Operation 100, officers located Maiden in the basement of the address suffering from injuries to his head/face and he appeared under the influence of alcohol. Maiden was read his Miranda Rights, agreed to speak with detectives and stated the following:
He was sitting on the couch in the living room attempting to install a ceiling fan along with and the victim. was in possession of the victim's handgun and began spinning the handgun around her finger. The handgun discharged twice striking the victim. He attempted to take the gun from but was unable to disarm her. began striking him with the firearm at which point he disengaged and went to the basement. He fell asleep in the basement and was awoken by member of the Kansas City Police Department.

Detectives obtained a search warrant and located the crime scene beginning in the home, on the west side of the residence, where a large window had been broken out; this occurred when officers were gaining entry to assist the victim. In the northwest bedroom was a pool of apparent blood on the floor. Two 9mm shell casings and one live 9mm round were present in the hallway outside of the bedroom, along with a pair of glasses. Two bullet holes were located in the floor of the hallway.
A computer printer was present in the middle of the living room with apparent blood. Two 9mm spent casings were located behind a couch in the living room. Near a different couch in the living room was one 9mm live round on the ground in front of it. A shirt was lying next to the live round with a black pistol magazine on top. A short distance away from the shirt, while still in the living room, was a black handgun, identified as a Taurus 9mm, bearing serial #ABC344551. A single 9mm spent shell casing was located on the small staircase leading into the garage.
