COMPLAINT WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. Property Damage 1st Degree (569.100-001Y20202999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.100, RSMo, committed the class E felony of property damage in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 5, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly damaged windows of a 2012 Lincoln MKX, which property was possessed by Karen Weiss by striking it, and the damages to such property exceeded seven hundred and fifty dollars.

The range punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count II. Property Damage 1st Degree (569.100-001Y20202999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.100, RSMo, committed the class E felony of property damage in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 5, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly damaged windows of a 2011 Ford Flex, which property was possessed by Stacee Showalter by striking it, and the damages to such property exceeded seven hundred and fifty dollars.

The range punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count III. Property Damage - 2nd Degree (569.120-001N20202999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.120, RSMo, committed the class B misdemeanor of property damage in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011 and 558.002, RSMo, in that on or about February 5, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly damaged 2017 Jeep Wrangler located at 1617 MAIN ST, which property was possessed by STACY DAVIS, by striking it.

The range of punishment for a class B misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed six (6) months; by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count IV. Property Damage - 2nd Degree (569.120-001N20202999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.120, RSMo, committed the class B misdemeanor of property damage in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011 and 558.002, RSMo, in that on or about February 5, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly damaged a 2016 Ford Escape located at 1617 MAIN ST, which property was possessed by Scott Setley, by striking it.

State vs. Daniel W Keil, Case No.

The range of punishment for a class B misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed six (6) months; by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
