COMPLAINT
WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. 565.050 - Assault - 2nd Degree - Special Victim (565.052-004Y20201311.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.052, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of assault in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about March 2, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant attempted to cause physical injury to Confidential Victim, a law enforcement officer in the performance of his official duties and special victim by means of a dangerous instrument by striking Confidential Victim with it.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count II. Stealing - Motor Vehicle/Watercraft/Aircraft (570.030-038Y20202499.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.030, RSMo, committed the class D felony of stealing, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 558.002, RSMo, in that on or about March 2, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant appropriated a bus, a motor vehicle, which property was owned by the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority, and the defendant appropriated such property without the consent of the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority and with the purpose to deprive the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority thereof.

The range punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count III. Tampering With Motor Vehicle - 1st Degree (569.080-002Y20202999.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.080.1(2), RSMo, committed the **class D felony of tampering in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 558.002, RSMo, in that on or about March 2, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly and without the consent of the owner unlawfully operated a city bus, an automobile.

The range punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
