The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 03/23/2024, [Redacted] Loss Prevention Detective, [Redacted] apprehended a suspect of shoplifting. [Redacted] was working in the [Redacted] Kansas City, Clay County, Missouri, location. [Redacted] recognized a prolific shoplifting suspect later identified as **Tajala JONES**, [Redacted] enter the store. [Redacted] observed **JONES** conceal the following items:

- 2 Girl clothing set - \$33.98
- 15 boy clothing set - \$254.85
- 1 infant Nike clothes - \$14.99
- 1 reusable bag - \$0.99
- 1 junior clothes set - \$24.99

[Redacted] observed **JONES** walk past all points of sale. [Redacted] confronted **JONES** on the sidewalk outside of the [Redacted] store. [Redacted] retrieved all the stolen items and verbally trespassed **JONES** from all [Redacted] store location in the United States. Before Officers could arrive, **JONES** fled on foot into a vehicle.

On 01/22/2025, Kansas City Missouri Police Officers were dispatched to [Redacted], Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, [Redacted] on a shoplifting call for service. When Officers arrived they contacted [Redacted] employee, who said **JONES**, had been in the store shoplifting. [Redacted] informed the Officers **JONES** is a prolific shoplifter from multiple [Redacted] store locations. **JONES** stole the following items:

- 4 kids basic girl's clothes - \$39.96
- 1 kid basic infant one piece - \$6.99
- 1 cell phone case - \$7.99
- 1 cologne - \$12.99

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██████████ provided Officers with an internal case along with pictures of **JONES** exiting the store. ██████████ saved video of the incident.

On 01/22/2025, Kansas City Missouri Police Detectives reviewed pictures provided from the shoplifting. Driver's license photos, booking photos, and photos provided by ██████████ were compared. After reviewing all the photos, **JONES** was determined to be the suspect.

On 02/20/2025, Kansas City Missouri Police Officers were dispatched to ██████████ Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. ██████████ on a shoplifting call for service. Officers contacted ██████████ employee, who advised **JONES** was in the store earlier and shoplifted the following items:

- 1 hgrn wvn set - \$12.99
- 1 pbf fut mesh - \$16.99
- 1 nkb b nsw soa flc short s - \$16.99
- 2 ss pique polo with short - \$28.98
- 1 dblu fut mesh - \$16.99
- 1 cotton crew pullover - \$24.99
- 1 lt blue ss floral woven - \$9.99
- 1 gred jm ft set - \$16.99
- 1 pink 3pc floral - \$12.99
- 1 2pk jersey ruffle - \$10.00
- 1 blu stitch bf cargo crew - \$13.00
- 1 echo pnk animal leg - \$16.00

██████████ provided the internal case along with pictures on **JONES**. Video of the incident was also captured and saved.

On 02/20/2025, Kansas City Missouri Police Detectives reviewed pictures provided from the shoplifting. Driver's license photos, booking photos, and photos provided by ██████████ were compared. After reviewing all the photos, **JONES** was determined to be the suspect.

Criminal History:

From 12/27/2019 to 02/21/2025, **JONES** has been listed as a subject/suspect in 19 Kansas City Missouri Police Reports to include, Robbery, Burglary and Shoplifting. The business' who she had primarily targeted were ██████████ Most of these business' reported the theft of clothing items.

On 09/15/2014, in Cass County Circuit Court, **JONES** was found guilty of Receiving Stolen Property, Class C Felony and sentenced to 5 years' probation. (Case# ██████████)
