AMENDED COMPLAINT

Count I. Burglary 1st Degree (569.160-001Y20202205.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.160, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of Burglary in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 22, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly entered unlawfully in a building, located at [REDACTED], Kansas City, Missouri and possessed by [REDACTED], for the purpose of committing the crime of Stealing therein, and while in such a building there was present in such a building [REDACTED], a person who was not a participant in the crime.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count II. Burglary 1st Degree (569.160-001Y20202205.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.160, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of Burglary in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 20, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly entered unlawfully in a building,

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located at [REDACTED], Kansas City, Missouri and possessed by [REDACTED], for the purpose of committing the crime of Stealing therein, and while in such a building there was present in such a building [REDACTED], a person who was not a participant in the crime.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
