The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 03-18-2025 at approximately 1713 hours officers of the Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri Police Department were attempting to conduct a traffic stop on a grey Jeep SUV. The Jeep's driver eluded the officers and was later found unoccupied in Kansas City, Kansas, after entering a parking garage. R#690, operating a Kansas City Missouri Police helicopter, was overhead following and relaying information to officers, stated the driver of the Jeep was now in the rear passenger of a black Infiniti. Prior to this the Infiniti had stopped and the passenger exited the vehicle before getting back in the rear passenger seat. Kansas Highway Patrol relayed the driver of a Infiniti had previously eluded them.

Kansas Highway Patrol Troopers followed the Infiniti until it reached the state line where they discontinued following it. R-690 continued overhead following the vehicle, providing information to officers in the area. At some point the passenger of the Infiniti bailed from the Infiniti and was taken into custody in the area of 700 Southwest Boulevard.

The driver of the Infiniti later identified as **Robert L. BEEBE (W/M 08-28-1990)** was observed driving in a careless manner via R#690's video. During the time the vehicle left the area of Southwest Boulevard to 16th and Summit, **BEEBE** drove into oncoming traffic and failed to stop at multiple traffic control devices. R#690 observed the Infiniti pulling into the parking lot, south of [REDACTED], and parking under a multi-space carport.

R#116's patrol vehicle has Police markings which are clear and visible. The patrol vehicle is equipped with red and blue emergency lights, which were activated during this incident.

R#116 was directed to the Infiniti and attempted to conduct a car check of the vehicle in the parking lot south of 1609 Jefferson. A few moments later R#690 reported shots were fired and requested more units and EMS to respond.

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Victim #1 [REDACTED] was doing a department approved ride along with R#116. She stated her ride along started at approximately 1700 hours and she was in the backseat of the patrol vehicle on the passenger side. Shortly into the ride along the officers received a call for service regarding what she believed to be a stolen vehicle.

Victim #1 [REDACTED] stated the following: The officers found the black vehicle and parked behind it. The two officers got out of the patrol car. They told her to stay in the car. Victim #1 stated the officers identified themselves as KCPD and requested **BEEBE** to exit the vehicle. **BEEBE** drove backwards then pulled forward, but didn't hit the police car. **BEEBE** backed out again hitting the police car. She stated she ducked down. She heard gunshots and yelling. She didn't see who was shot. She then observed several officers responding to the scene.

The #1 victim also stated she felt the impact of the patrol vehicle being struck. She later stated she observed the officers get **BEEBE** out of the vehicle to render aid to him.

The #2 victim stated R#690 located the Infiniti at [REDACTED]. He and his partner responded to the location to conduct a car check. He and his partner yelled commands at **BEEBE** to exit the vehicle. He was going to approach the vehicle when the Infiniti moved forward and struck a parking sign. **BEEBE** then backed the vehicle up. He further stated he heard the Infiniti, hit his partner's side of the patrol vehicle.

The victim/on-duty officer stated **BEEBE** of the Infiniti backed up and revved its engine, as if to strike the patrol vehicle again. He stated he didn't have the best view before hearing sounds of shots. He looked and realized his partner/witness on-duty officer, was holding a gun and giving commands to **BEEBE**, driver of the Infiniti. The #2 victim stated he soon realized his partner (witness on-duty officer) had shot **BEEBE**. He assisted **BEEBE** out of the driver seat and onto the ground to render aid. He stated several other officers responded and assisted them.

The #2 victim also stated he couldn't see **BEEBE** before the shooting. The tint on the Infiniti was too dark. He believes neither he nor his partner were in their patrol vehicle, when **BEEBE** drove the Infiniti into the patrol vehicle. The #2 victim stated he did not have view of his partner at the time the Infiniti struck the patrol car.

The #2 victim further stated he believed the Infiniti was driving in the direction of his partner. Victim #2 stated he heard three gunshots before he got around the patrol vehicle. He stated he then heard two more gunshots. The area was small and he did not believe the Infiniti could have gotten around the patrol vehicle to exit the parking lot.

BEEBE was transported to an area hospital for treatment of his injuries.

A search warrant was requested and granted by Jackson County Judge Keil, for the black 4-door 2013 Infiniti [REDACTED]. The vehicle was a reported stolen auto on 03-06-2025 (KC25013331). The Kansas license plate of [REDACTED], displayed on the vehicle is issued to a different vehicle.

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During the execution of the search warrant 9mm Smith and Wesson bearing serial number [REDACTED] was recovered from the front driver side floorboard. The firearm was reported stolen on 02-13-2025 (KC25008923). The firearm was loaded with live rounds.

On 03-19-2025 **BEEBE** was advised of his Miranda Rights and declined to speak with detectives at 1037 hours.

The case Detective is requesting an arrest warrant in lieu of a summons for the listed offender as the circumstances of the crime was violent in nature. "**BEEBE**" has had prior contacts with law enforcement Officers and is currently on state probation for Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance.

In light of the recent incident and his recent conduct, the case Detective believes the offender is a danger to the public.
