mustache and a black shirt walks from around the first two white trucks and a taller stocky white male with dark hair exits the black truck wearing a shirt. They walk to the side of building while looking at .
Detectives were able to identify two of the subjects from the video as James "Mike" BASHAM, white/male, and through Missouri Drives License photos.
arrived to Metro Patrol for a formal interview with detectives. They both said they work for and arrived to to interview any employee at the business. They were turned down for an interview but were able to talk with one person who recovered their vehicle from the tow lot. After the interview sat across the street in a vacant lot in their running vehicle to film a live story later in the day. Said they had apparel on and their vehicle had a "Media" placard in the front windshield. The employees knew they worked for the news station and would have seen them exit and enter their vehicle. Stayed where they parked on the east side of the street in the abandoned lot at Next to the right side of their vehicles was a small fence. After sitting for approximately 45 minutes one white arrived and backed in near the front of their vehicle on the left side. A few moments later three other tow trucks arrived with markings visibly affixed to the side of the trucks. A white tow truck parked directly in front of their vehicle, a black flatbed tow truck backed in on the driver side, and a blue flatbed tow truck backed in blocking there are of the vehicle. Both said he believed they were trying to intimidate them by blocking them in. Was worried for his and safety and was nervous. Said she called 911 because she was afraid of what they might do since there was no escape for them. After the first vehicle backed in knew something was wrong and was nervous so he began to film the interaction. described the ordeal as a threat and felt the tow company was sending a message to them. After a short time, Officers arrived and asked for the tow drivers to move their trucks from blocking them in.
On 04/16/2025, Kansas City Missouri Police Officers located BASHAM at City, Clay County, Missouri. Officers contacted BASHAM at the address and took him into custody without issue. He was transported to the Kansas City Missouri Police Metro Patrol Detention and placed on an investigative hold for Harassment/Threats.
On 04/17/2025, Kansas City Missouri Property Crimes Police Detectives interviewed BASHAM at the Metro Patrol Detention. BASHAM was escorted to an interview room where he was read the Standard Miranda Warning and Waiver and agreed to talk.
Detectives asked BASHAM about the shown a picture of a black and he confirmed that was the one he was driving. Pictures were shown of the other male on site and he did not know that male even though he had the same shirt on BASHAM had. BASHAM said he was not called to the area to block in.
The interview was completed and BASHAM was escorted back to detention staff.
