The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 04/12/2025, at 1855 hours, officer [REDACTED] and officer [REDACTED] with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were operating a marked KCPD patrol vehicle and wearing marked KCPD uniforms. They conducted a traffic violation of a group of ATV's and motorcycles at Truman Rd West and Main St, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. During the stop [REDACTED] attempted to remove an operator of a black and lime green Yamaha Raptor 700 from his vehicle in order to place him into custody. At that time the suspect reversed his ATV, causing [REDACTED] to fall to the ground. The ATV continued to reverse, running over [REDACTED] leg. [REDACTED] then attempted to get to his feet. While [REDACTED] was in a crouched position, the suspect lifted his ATV into a wheelie, striking [REDACTED] in the face causing further injury and causing him to fall backwards onto the ground, striking his head on the pavement. As [REDACTED] fell backwards, the ATV continued forward, maintaining the wheelie, until he was above [REDACTED]. At that time the suspect dropped the front wheels of the vehicle onto [REDACTED] and accelerated forward running over him with all four tires. The suspect fled the scene and was not taken into custody. [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital with serious injuries.

On 04/12/2025 at 1902 hours Real Time Crime Center directed officers to the area of 31st St and Southwest Boulevard, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. Officers located the suspect in a gravel parking lot on the north-west side of Southwest Blvd at 31st St and attempted to conduct a car check of the suspect, however the suspect immediately fled westbound on Southwest Boulevard, crossing into Kansas. Officers initiated a pursuit and followed the suspect into Kansas where the suspect turned northbound on 7th St from Southwest Boulevard, Kansas City, Wyandotte County, Kansas. The suspect continued with officers in pursuit to the area of 7th St and Kansas Ave where the suspect looped around the median three times before traveling eastbound on Kansas Ave across the bridge into Missouri. The officers lost sight of the suspect at American Royal Driver and Avenida Ceaser E Chavez, Kansas City, Jackson County Missouri. Several officers in the area continued to canvass for the suspect and he was reacquired at 7th St and Cheyenne Ave, Kansas City, Wyandotte County, Kansas where again officers attempted to conduct a stop of the suspect who fled once again. Officer [REDACTED] initiated a pursuit of the suspect southbound on 7th St before turning westbound on Southwest Boulevard. The suspect continued to

flee, traveling into oncoming lanes of traffic. The suspect the turned northbound on Mission Rd and traveled northbound in the southbound lanes until he reached I-35 Highway. The suspect then entered onto the exit ramp for I-35 southbound and continued driving northbound in the southbound lanes of I-35 Highway traveling from Kansas back into Jackson County, Missouri. The suspect continued northbound in southbound lanes of traffic on the highway, weaving between lanes of travel, nearly striking several vehicles and causing several vehicles to have to drive evasively to avoid a collision. The pursuit was terminated in the area of E 12th St and I-35 Highway, Kansas City, Jackson County Missouri due to the northbound and southbound lanes diverging and officers losing visual contact with the suspect.

A review of [REDACTED]'s body worn camera showed the suspect to be a white male with shoulder length brown or red hair. The suspect was wearing a dark green coat, gray pants, black and white shoes, blue gloves, a silver cross necklace, and a black balaclava face mask. During the attempt to take COLEMAN into custody, the pair of gray headphones worn by the suspect were knocked off. The headphones remained on scene and were recovered with DNA analysis pending. The ATV was identified as a Yamaha Raptor 700R SE with aftermarket extended footrests with red cloth straps, and aftermarket gray and red handguards.

On 4/14/2025 Detectives received a TIP that the suspect who ran over the officer was Kendall Shawn COLEMAN. Detectives conducted a search of Niche and located Kendall COLEMAN W/M DOB: 05/08/1997. Further investigation was conducted into COLEMAN and Missouri DOR photos and booking photos were located. Later in the day, [REDACTED] called the Assault Unit and advised she provided the TIP. She was told this information by an acquaintance of COLEMAN, but would not identify who told her the information

Detectives reviewed city cameras which captured the suspect ATV, along with several other ATV's and motorcycles leaving the area of Penn Valley Park at 1848 hours, traveling eastbound on East 31st Street and then northbound on Main Street until the assault occurred. Detectives reviewed more city cameras and located the suspect ATV, along with a green and white motorcycle driving south through the grass of Penn Valley Park from East 27th Street and Summit Street at 1817 hours. Detectives were able to capture the suspect ATV and green and white motorcycle pulling into Royal Liquor, 801 Southwest Boulevard, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri at 1759 hours. Detectives recovered video surveillance from Royal Liquors. Video shows the suspect ATV and the green and white motorcycle driving in the parking lot, doing wheelies. The video shows COLEMAN entering the store and making purchases, operating a cell phone, leaving and then later exiting the parking lot southbound on Summit Street towards Penn Valley Park at 1816 hours. COLEMAN is seen wearing a dark green coat, gray pants, black and white shoes, blue gloves, a silver cross necklace, and a black balaclava face mask, and gray Bluetooth headphones on videos reviewed. The facemask was pulled down allowing the suspects face to be clearly seen and compared to a DOR photo.

A search was conducted for COLEMAN's most recent phone number which resulted in the number 816-237-6947. This number was confirmed by three separate investigative services. Missouri Highway Patrol confirmed that COLEMAN had an account at Harrah's North Kansas City, registered with the same phone number, the ID associated with that same account was used on 02/22/2025. The same phone was also confirmed to belong to a CashApp account registered to the name Kendall COLEMAN. Cell phone data received from Verizon upon service of a search warrant showed that the phone with that phone number, registered to Kendall COLEMAN, was at the scene of the assault on the date and time the assault occurred.

On 04/15/2025, the owner of Royal Liquor at 801 Southwest Blvd, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, was contacted to compare his sales records for the time that COLEMAN made a purchase. The manager provided a physical receipt with a timestamp of 6:07 PM which aligns with the video timestamp of 1807 showing COLEMAN swiping his credit card. The receipt lists the cardholder of Visa account 8557 as KENDALL COLEMAN.

Kendall COLEMAN is a convicted felon for the following offenses:

On 05/13/2009, Jackson County Circuit Court, Deliver Controlled Substance – Felony. Count 2 Guilty. Case Number: 1716CR0279801

On 05/13/2009, Jackson County Circuit Court, Unlawful use of a Weapon – Felony. Count 3 Guilty. Case Number: 1716CR0279801
