The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 05/10/2025 at approximately 1408 hours, officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department responded to World's Liquor & Tobacco (Shell Gas Station) located at 8435 E. 63rd Trafficway, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a male suffering from apparent trauma. Raytown, Missouri Fire Department EMS responded and transported the male, later identified as [REDACTED] to Research Medical Center, where he was pronounced deceased at 1442 hours by medical staff. The 1020 Homicide Squad responded to the scene and a homicide investigation was initiated.

Video surveillance from World's Liquor & Tobacco revealed a white vehicle arrive and the victim and an unknown party in a red shirt exit the vehicle. They pass a group of four black males standing near the front doors of the business before entering the business at approximately 1305 hours (DVR time, which is approximately one hour behind from real time). After the victim enters the store, one of the male suspects (wearing a dark head covering, glasses, a dark t-shirt with a skull design, dark shorts, and dark shoes, later identified as [REDACTED]) standing in front of the business leans in and speaks to another male suspect who was wearing a dark hoodie with the hood up and dark pants (later identified as **K'Vontaye REDMOND-GUESS B/M 05/02/2002**). [REDACTED] then walks over to the other two black males and appears to speak to them before they go into the business, leaving [REDACTED] and **REDMOND-GUESS** outside. As the victim exits the store, [REDACTED] grabs him by the jacket while simultaneously pointing a firearm at him. **REDMOND-GUESS** stands behind [REDACTED] and pulls a firearm from his pocket as [REDACTED] confronts the victim. The victim attempts to back up and produces a firearm but drops it as [REDACTED] fires at him. **REDMOND-GUESS** backs up and points his firearm at the victim as he lays on the ground. [REDACTED] picks up the victim's firearm before running eastbound through the parking lot. **REDMOND-GUESS** flees around the rear of World's Liquor & Tobacco.

Video surveillance from Price Chopper, located at 8700 E. 63rd Street, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, showed **REDMOND-GUESS** enter the business a short time after the shooting and contact a white male witness

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(later identified as [REDACTED]) and an unidentified black female. **REDMOND-GUESS** gives [REDACTED] a sweatshirt before exiting the business.

At approximately 1631 hours, detectives were conducting an area canvas near QuikTrip located at 8733 E. 63rd Street, Raytown, Jackson County, Missouri and recognized a white male matching [REDACTED] description from the Price Chopper (which is just north of QuikTrip) video surveillance as the individual **REDMOND-GUESS** had given his hoodie to. As [REDACTED] exited QuikTrip, he proceeded westbound on foot where he met up with three individuals, including a black male matching the description of **REDMOND-GUESS**. Officers conducted a pedestrian check and identified [REDACTED] and **REDMOND-GUESS**. The other two individuals were identified as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] provided a formal statement and advised he was inside Price Chopper when "K'Vontaye" walked up to him and handed him a black hooded sweatshirt and then left. [REDACTED] then walked to 8705 E. 61st Terrace Apt #57. Upon entering the apartment, he heard "K'Vontaye" and [REDACTED] talking about shooting a guy and observed them to be changing their clothes and passing a gray handgun with a green grip and extended magazine back and forth. Both "K'Vontaye" and [REDACTED] were talking about how this firearm belonged to the victim who was just shot. [REDACTED] advised that sometime later, he left the apartment and eventually met up with Hyde- [REDACTED]. He stated "K'Vontaye" caught up with them shortly before they were contacted by the police. [REDACTED] identified a single photo of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated, the day before (05/09/2025) [REDACTED] was talking about "doing a lick" and robbing somebody.

[REDACTED] provided a formal statement and advised that earlier in the afternoon [REDACTED] entered the apartment together where she was sleeping with Traylor, and began yelling about needing to change clothes, and how he [REDACTED] "upped" on a guy at the Shell Gas Station and robbed him for his gun. She then observed [REDACTED] change his clothes in the bathroom of apartment #57 and begin rummaging through the apartment. She stated sometime later, she and [REDACTED] left the apartment together before meeting back up with [REDACTED] and "Von" at the location where police contacted them. [REDACTED] "Von" (**REDMOND-GUESS**) as being one of the individuals she was with when police contacted them, and identified a single photo of [REDACTED] as [REDACTED]

Detectives initially interviewed **REDMOND-GUESS** in a police vehicle on scene. His involvement in this offense was unknown at the onset of the interview, but he was similar in appearance to one of the suspects captured on surveillance video. During the initial interview, **REDMOND-GUESS** admitted he was at the scene where this offense occurred, standing next to the propane tanks. He advised he observed a male (victim) exit the store when another male (suspect, later identified as [REDACTED]) walked up to **REDMOND-GUESS** and stated the male who just exited the store was someone who had "snitched" on him. **REDMOND-GUESS** stated [REDACTED] walked up to the victim and a struggle ensued, during which the victim "upped a gun" on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then produced his own gun and shot the victim. **REDMOND-GUESS** stated he fled the scene on foot into the woods. **REDMOND-GUESS** claimed not to know either individual. Detectives advised **REDMOND-GUESS** store surveillance captures him producing a handgun and firing it. **REDMOND-GUESS** admitted he produced a handgun but claimed he did not fire it. When asked where his gun was, **REDMOND-GUESS** claimed he had discarded it when he fled the scene. At this point, the decision was made to place **REDMOND-GUESS** under arrest. The interview was ceased and **REDMOND-GUESS** was placed in

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handcuffs and transported to Police Headquarters and placed in Interview Room #2 on the 7th Floor. Detectives re-contacted **REDMOND-GUESS** and he provided a statement consistent with his original statement after being advised of his rights per Miranda. **REDMOND-GUESS** initially maintained he did not know the individual who shot the victim, but reiterated the victim had attempted to produce a handgun, but [REDACTED] knocked it away and shot the victim. As the interview progressed, **REDMOND-GUESS** stated he had walked to the scene of this offense with [REDACTED] and ultimately admitted he knew him as [REDACTED]. **REDMOND-GUESS** advised he and [REDACTED] were standing outside the business doors when the victim walked out and became engaged in a confrontation with him and [REDACTED]. During the confrontation, the victim attempted to produce a handgun but [REDACTED] was able to outdraw him and shot the victim. **REDMOND-GUESS** then stated he no longer wished to talk and the interview was ceased.

It should be noted, **REDMOND-GUESS'** statement is not consistent with the video surveillance collected from World's Liquor & Tobacco.
