I have probable cause to believe that on 05/13/2025, at W 37 St and Pennsylvania Ave in
(Date) (Address)Kansas City, Jackson County Missouri Rasheed M. Turner
(County) (Name of Offender(s))[Redacted] committed one or more criminal offense(s).
(Description of Identity)

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 05/13/2025 at 2146 hours, Kansas City, Missouri Police Officers were dispatched to W. 37th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a shooting. Upon their arrival a female was located in the street, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds, near a parked Chevrolet Malibu. KCFD/EMS responded to the scene and confirmed the female to be deceased. She was later identified as [Redacted].

Crime scene technicians responded, processed the scene and collected evidence, including numerous shell casings. The Jackson County Medical Examiner's Office Investigators responded to the scene and collected the deceased. The vehicle parked near the deceased was a 2013 Chevrolet Malibu bearing Missouri license [Redacted]. It was determined to be registered to the deceased's mother. The exterior was swabbed, printed, and towed from the scene for later interior processing.

During the area canvass, neighbors reported hearing 3-4 sounds of gunshots, a woman screaming something to the effect of "Please don't, no... please" followed by 3-4 more sounds of gunshots. They also reported hearing the sound of screeching tires and when they looked out, observed a person laying in the street near a vehicle with its passenger door open. Some reported seeing a male exit from the passenger side of the Malibu and run to the driver side of a blue Ford Mustang with a black convertible top before fleeing the scene in the blue Ford Mustang.

[Redacted], the mother of the deceased, was tracking the location of the deceased's cell phone. She attempted to contact the deceased multiple times and, when she did not answer, [Redacted] drove to the scene and recognized her [Redacted] vehicle parked at the scene. She stated the deceased had the vehicle when she left home. [Redacted] signed a consent to search form at the scene for detectives to process the vehicle and retrieve the cell phone belonging to the deceased.

█, the cousin of the deceased, stated she was on FaceTime with the victim at 1829 hours. They were talking about their plans for the evening due to it being the deceased's birthday. During that conversation the deceased told █ that she was going to meet with "**Rasheed**" (ex-boyfriend). The deceased told her "**Rasheed**," (identified as **Rasheed M. Turner** █) convinced her to meet with him because he had a birthday present for her. █ stated the deceased told her **TURNER** was there and ready to go so she would have to call █ back. █ took a screenshot of the deceased during this call.

█ stated when she did not hear from the deceased, she called her again via FaceTime at 1952 hours. This time the deceased appeared to be crying (had tears in her eyes). The deceased told her she was still with **TURNER**, they were still talking and she would have to call her back. █ stated she sent the deceased a text message at 2201 hours, however, did not get a response.

City cameras and license plate readers in the area were searched for a blue Ford Mustang with a black convertible top. At 21:40:33 hours, a blue Ford Mustang with a black convertible top was captured on city cameras travelling southbound on Pennsylvania Avenue and turned westbound on W 38 Street. The vehicle appeared to have a burned out or missing driver's headlight and had the Missouri license plate of █. The vehicle was then captured exiting W. 38th Street turning southbound onto Southwest Trafficway at 21:40:08 hours, and continuing south on Southwest Trafficway, captured on the LPR at 21:40:30.

Police information databases were then checked for prior license plate reads. On 09/09/2024 an LPR captured the Chevrolet Malibu and Ford Mustang parked next to each other at 15229 Grand Summit BLVD, Grandview, Missouri. Reports from the Grandview Police Department listed █ being involved in two domestic violence assaults at █. The reports were dated from 12/28/2024 and 04/06/2025 both listed █ and an individual named **TURNER, Rasheed M** █.

A search of the deceased's name in MULES responded with a temporary protection order with the deceased being the protected party and **TURNER** being the respondent. In the order **TURNER's** cell phone number was listed as being █.

█ provided the lock code for the deceased's iPhone. The deceased's cell phone had text messages from the █ cell phone number. That same number began messaging the deceased on 05/13/2025 at 1130 hours. The messages state "I miss you man." At 1153 hours the deceased responded "U ain't tell me happy birthday when u called me." **TURNER** responded at 1214 hours, "I wanted to tell you face to face & give you my present for you". The two exchange messages including the deceased talking about getting a tattoo and **TURNER** asking to see the deceased. At 1810 hours, the deceased texted "I just finished getting my tattoo" and **TURNER** responded "Okay so you ready?" At 1831 hours, the █ number called the deceased's phone. The call appeared to last 9 minutes.

Facebook Messenger belonging to the deceased showed a conversation from April 27th with an individual named "Mafiosõ Morris." The messages from "Mafiosõ Morris" to the deceased appeared to be confrontational and "Mafiosõ Morris" trying to meet up to profess his love for the deceased. At 0149 hours, the deceased called "Mafiosõ Morris" by the name "Rasheed." The Facebook for "Mafiosõ Morris" has a profile picture of what appears to be an older photograph of a female with her hand up to her mouth holding what appears to be a cookie.

The username "Mafiosõ Morris" was searched on Facebook. A profile was located with the same name and the previously described profile picture. The original name for the Facebook profile appeared to be "sheed.stackadolla." Photographs of a Blue colored Ford Mustang with a black convertible top were located. The paint on the vehicle appeared to be blue spray paint. Photographs of a white colored Ford Mustang with a black convertible top, were also observed prior to ones featuring the blue Mustang. The vehicle had the same rims in the photos and the wear on the convertible top appeared to be in the same locations. A partially blacked out license plate was located from a picture posted on 06/06/2023. The plate had the first and last characters mostly visible and were determined to be [REDACTED] at the beginning and [REDACTED] at the end. Photographs of **TURNER** are also observed.

The license plate [REDACTED] was searched in Flock, a database of license plate readers throughout the nation. The plate was observed in Lee's Summit, Missouri, on 470 at N. City travelling northbound at 0227 hours. The last plate read was New Halls Ferry Rd and Pershall Rd travelling southbound in Ferguson Missouri. The blue Ford Mustang was observed in the captured photo.

At the time of this case submittal **TURNER** is not in custody and his location is unknown.
