The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 06-01-2025 at 2022 hours, Officers with the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were initially dispatched to [REDACTED] before being redirected to the crime scene located [REDACTED] in regard to a shooting.

Upon arrival officers located the victim, identified as [REDACTED], laying on the ground inside the door way of [REDACTED] with a black female, witness #1, standing over him attempting to render aid. [REDACTED] was transported to an area hospital with life threatening injuries, however [REDACTED] was declared deceased at 2054 hours.

A search warrant was obtained for [REDACTED]. A review of the crime scene showed four bullet holes penetrating the front door. Four shell casings stamped "CBC 40 S&W" were located to the immediate south of the residence off the porch. Two firearms were recovered from inside the residence. One was holstered on the coffee table and one was found under a couch cushion. Neither firearm appears to have been involved in the incident.

Witness #1 stated she was with her boyfriend Shawn Allen BM 12-09-1998 earlier in the night. She explained she had had an argument with him and left him. She elected to go to [REDACTED] to meet [REDACTED] in order to purchase Marijuana. Witness #1 explained she has been buying from [REDACTED] for approximately four years. While inside she made her purchase, but was playing with his puppies when she began receiving calls from Allen. Witness #1 ignored two calls from Allen before answering a third. Allen told her to get out of the house because he was about to "shoot up" the residence. Witness #1 continued to stay inside the residence believing it was safer to do so.

When Witness #1 went to leave the residence she immediately saw Allen charging up toward the house with a gun. She heard him say "What did you say? What did you say?" Allen then fired four rounds into the front door

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of the residence. Witness #1 ran to her car and hid and watched as Allen fled in his silver four door car he had arrived in. Witness #1 indicated she believed it was a Ford sedan, but was unsure of the model.

Witness #1 provided Allen's, name and birthday and confirmed his identify from a booking photo. Additionally, Witness #1 provided Allen's current cell phone number as [REDACTED].

A search in CLEAR verified the number [REDACTED] is an active account subscribed to Shawn Allen, operated by Aerial Communications, Inc., an affiliate of T-Mobile.

A tip was received from a woman who stated she was driving eastbound on 29th Street at the time of the shooting and stated she heard four gunshots and then saw a black male wearing a white tank top run to a four-door silver car parked in the middle of the roadway. She also stated she saw a black female that appeared to be hiding from the male behind a car parked on the east side of the road. This tip corroborates Witness #1's account of the incident. The tipster stated she then continued east on [REDACTED] and did not see the direction of travel of the suspect. Tipster stated she was in a 2013 Chevy Silverado with a white cab and black bed. This vehicle is observed in surveillance obtained from [REDACTED] at the time of the shooting.

Witness #2 stated he was in front of his residence when he heard a black male yell "What did you say? What did you say?" before running up toward the house and firing 3 to 5 rounds. Witness #2 stated the suspect arrived in a silver four door sedan. Witness #2 then ran inside his residence and did not see where the suspect went after the shooting. Witness #2 provided Ring Doorbell that captured what is believed to be a Silver Ford Fusion back into frame before suddenly stopping. A black male in a white tank top is seen getting out of the driver seat and running in the direction of [REDACTED]. A woman can be heard screaming "No, No, No" before four gunshots are heard. At the end of the video, the black male is seen returning to the Ford Fusion.

Witness #3 state he saw a black male get out of a silver four door vehicle and run toward [REDACTED] armed with a handgun and heard four gunshots.

On 06/02/2025, detectives obtained a search warrant allowing them to "ping" the cell phone owned by Shawn Allen in order to locate and arrest him. On 06/03/2025, detectives conducted surveillance on a residence in the area of [REDACTED] Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. Detectives observed Allen get into the driver seat of a 2011 silver Ford Fusion, which matched the description of the suspect vehicle from the homicide scene. Allen appeared to be the sole occupant of the vehicle. At that time, detectives called for Tactical Response Team officers to move in and arrest Allen. Allen was taken into custody without incident a short time later. After Allen was in custody, detectives observed a handgun with an extended magazine in plain view on the floor board of the silver Ford Fusion. The handgun was sticking out from underneath the front driver's seat, and was easily accessible to Allen when he was seated in the vehicle. The firearm was recovered by KCPD CSI personnel. 10 of the 16 rounds in the magazine were "CBC 40 S&W", which matched the shell casings located at the scene of the homicide.

An initial review of cell phone data obtained via a time advance search warrant indicates the cell phone belonging to Shawn Allen was in the area of [REDACTED] at the time of the shooting. It further confirms

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statements made by Witness #1 that Allen had been repeatedly calling her while she was inside [REDACTED].

Allen was transported to KCPD Headquarters for an interview with detectives. Allen was read his Miranda Rights, and indicated he understood his rights. During the interview Allen denied having committed a murder, however admitted to being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm. Admitted to owning a 2011 Silver Ford Fusion and acknowledged cell phone data would likely place him near the scene of the murder as he was making repeated calls to Witness #1 at or about the time of the murder.

Following the interview, Allen was transported to Metro Patrol Division for booking.

A check of Allen's Criminal History showed him to have under case number 2316-CR02901-01 a conviction for Assault in the 2nd Degree (D Felony) and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm (D felony) in Jackson County District Court on Dec. 18th, 2023. Allen was sentenced to 7 years prison and 3 years of probation.

Due to the nature of the crime that is being alleged, a bond is being requested to prevent flight or danger to the public.
