The range punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count VII. Property Damage 1st Degree (569.100-001Y20202901.)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.100, RSMo, committed the class C felony of property damage in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002, 558.011, and 569.100.2 RSMo, in that on or about March 26, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, acting alone or purposefully in concert with another, knowingly damaged an ATM machine at

attempting to gain access to the ATM's contents, and the damages to such property exceeded seven hundred and fifty dollars, and the ATM was a teller machine.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three year and not to exceed ten years, or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been

gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.
