# **COMPLAINT**

#### Count I. Assault 1st Degree (565.050-002Y19791304.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **Class B Felony of Assault in the First Degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant shot at and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of attempting to kill or cause serious physical injury to and was done for the purpose of committing such assault.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.


#### Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the

defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

## Count III. Assault 1st Degree (565.050-002Y19791304.0)



An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

#### Count IV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count III, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

#### Count V. Assault 1st Degree (565.050-002Y19791304.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **Class B Felony of Assault in the First Degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of

Missouri, the defendant shot at an and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the crime of attempting to kill or cause serious physical injury to and was done for the purpose of committing such assault.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

#### Count VII. Assault 1st Degree (565.050-002Y19791304.0)

RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the First Degree charged in Count VII, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

## Count IX. Stealing A Motor Vehicle - 1st Offense (570.030-008Y19192404.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.030, RSMo, committed the **Class C Felony of Stealing**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant appropriated a motor vehicle which property was in the possession of and with the purpose to deprive him thereof.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

## Count X. Unlawful Possession Of A Firearm (571.070-001Y20085212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of 571.070, RSMo, committed the **Class C Felony of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm**, punishable under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly possessed a black handgun, a firearm, and on April 6, 2007, the defendant was convicted of the felony of Robbery in the Second Degree in Jackson County Circuit Court case number 0616-CR05231-01.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

## Count XI. Possession Of Up To 35 Grams Of Marijuana (195.202-003Y20093562.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 195.202, RSMo, committed the **Class A Misdemeanor of Possession of a Controlled Substance**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.016, RSMo, in that on or about August 10, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant possessed marijuana, a controlled substance, knowing of its presence and nature.

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
