Count I. Assault/attempt Assault 2nd Degree On Law Enforcement Officer, Corrections Officer, Emergency Personnel, Highway Worker, Utility Worker Or Probation And Parole Officer By Means Other Than Deadly Weapon Or Dangerous Instrument/physical Injury (565.082-002Y20051399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.082, RSMo, committed the Class C Felony of Assault of a law enforcement officer in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 11, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused physical injury to PO

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count II. Assault/attempt Assault 2nd Degree On Law Enforcement Officer, Corrections Officer, Emergency Personnel, Highway Worker, Utility Worker Or Probation And Parole Officer By Means Other Than Deadly Weapon Or Dangerous Instrument/physical Injury (565.082-002Y20051399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.082, RSMo, committed the Class C Felony of assault of a law enforcement officer in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 11, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused physical injury to PO a law enforcement officer, by biting her.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count III. Assault 3rd Degree - Pursuant To Subdivisions (1), (2), (4) And (6) (565.070-002Y20101399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.070, RSMo, committed the Class A Misdemeanor of Assault in the third degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.016, RSMo, in that on or about August 11, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant attempted to cause physical injury to by striking her.

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
