The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.034, RSMo, committed the class C felony of statutory rape in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that Between December 1, 2014 and June 30, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant had sexual intercourse with and at that time was less than seventeen years old and the defendant was twenty-one years of age or older.

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
