# **COMPLAINT**

#### **Count I. Kidnapping - 1st Degree (565.110-001Y19001006.0)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.110, RSMo, committed the Class A Felony of Kidnapping in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, defendant unlawfully confined \_\_\_\_\_\_. for a substantial period, without her consent for the purpose of facilitating the commission of a felony.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

#### **Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Kidnapping in the first degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Kidnapping in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

#### Count III. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **Class A Felony of Robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant forcibly stole U.S. currency in the possession of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, and in the course thereof defendant, was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

#### Count IV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Robbery in the first degree charged in Count III, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.060, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Sodomy in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.060, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of defendant, knowingly had deviate sexual intercourse with \_\_\_\_\_\_, by the use of forcible compulsion by placing 's hand on his penis.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

#### **Count XII. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Sodomy in the first degree charged in Count XI, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Sodomy in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.100, RSMo, committed the Class B Felony of Sexual Abuse in the first degree punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735 and Section 559.106, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly had sexual contact with by use of forcible compulsion by placing his mouth on 's breast for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of defendant and, in the course of such conduct, defendant displayed a deadly weapon in a threatening manner.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

#### Count XIV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **Felony of Armed Criminal Action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about February 3, 2017, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Sexual Abuse in the first degree charged in Count XIII, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Sexual Abuse in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The victim stated at 0515 hours she walked out of her apartment building, and to her vehicle parked on Harrison St. just north of 39<sup>th</sup> St. She entered her vehicle and before she could lock or start the car the driver door was opened by **Odums**. The victim screamed and **Odums** held a knife to her side stating "shut the fuck up." **Odums** then entered the back driver side seat, placed the knife against the victim's neck and stated "drive where I tell you to drive." She began driving west and was forced to stop the vehicle on the side of Holmes Rd. just north of 39<sup>th</sup> St. **Odums** demanded money at which time the victim gave him twenty dollars she had in her pocket. **Odums** then forced her to continue driving and directed her to the Bank of America located at 331 Westport Rd. **Odums** told her to withdraw \$500; however, she did not have the funds on the card she was attempting to use and only withdrew \$140-\$160. She was then instructed to drive to the Great American Bank located at 3901 Main St. The ATM would not work at this location and she did not withdraw any money. **Odums** then forced her to drive to the Bank of America located at 3100 Main St. where she was able to withdraw \$240 before telling the suspect she could not withdraw any more funds.

At this point **Odums** made the victim start driving again. The victim is not familiar with the area and does not remember the exact route she took. **Odums** continued giving the victim instructions on when and where to turn. After driving around for a short period of time **Odums** forced the victim to park the vehicle on the side of the road in front of a house, in a residential area. **Odums** then removed the victim's work identification badge from

her shirt and began saying her name while masturbating. He then forced the victim into the back seat of the vehicle. **Odums** forced the victim to remove her pants and underwear and "make herself wet." He then attempted to penetrate the victim's vagina with his penis. The victim stated he penetrated her vagina, but not fully. **Odums** became angry and forced the victim to use her hands and masturbate his penis. He then forced the victim to bend over the back seat and penetrated her vagina with his penis. He was again unable to penetrate her vagina fully. She was then forced onto her back and **Odums** briefly performed oral sex on her. He then removed her right breast from her shirt and bra and began sucking on it. **Odums** then penetrated her vagina again and was able to force his penis fully inside her vagina for a short period of time before he began masturbating and ejaculated in the back seat of the vehicle.

**Odums** then used papers that were inside the vehicle in an attempt to clean the ejaculate. He also used dash board wet wipes the victim had in the vehicle to wipe the windows and several others areas inside the car. **Odums** then forced the victim back into the front driver seat and told her "don't think about calling the police, obviously I know where you live and if you do that, I'll just kill you next time." **Odums** then fled in an unknown direction.

The victim then responded to Central Patrol Division station where she was taken to St. Luke's Hospital for a SANE exam.

From the SANE exam and samples recovered from the crime scene the Kansas City, Missouri Police Crime Lab was able to develop a full genetic profile from an unknown male source. This profile was entered into CODIS and a hit responded back to **Odums**, a convicted offender in Louisiana.

On 02/14/2017 at 1515 hours **Odums** was taken into custody. He was later advised of his Miranda Rights which he stated he understood and wished to provide a statement. **Odums** was presented a photograph of the victim and asked if he recognized her. He stated he does not recognize the pictured female and has never met her. He has never been inside her vehicle. **Odums** was advised his DNA was collected from a breast swab of the victim. When given these facts and asked, if he has never met the victim, why his DNA was found on her person, he responded by saying, it must either be a mistake, or he has a twin somewhere.

**Odums** continually denied having any involvement in this incident. He could not provide any reasonable explanation for the presence of his DNA.

**Odums** was presented with a signed search warrant for a DNA buccal swab and head and pubic hair standards. He advised he would not cooperate with the collection of these items and was then placed into handcuffs. KCPD Crime Scene Technician Simmons then explained he would be collecting the buccal sample from **Odums** cheek, at which time **Odums** sat on the floor, closed his mouth and leaned his head forward in between his legs. Detectives were able to lift his head and open his mouth while the buccal swab was collected. **Odums** then complied while the remaining articles were collected.
