Count I. Assault - 3rd Degree - Special Victim (565.054-001Y20171312.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.054, RSMo, committed the class D felony of assault in the third degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 26, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, either acting alone or purposely in concert with another, knowingly caused physical injury to a corrections officer performing his official duties and special victim, by repeatedly kicking and punching

The range of punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

	ive Audrey Kelley, a deputy with the Jackson County, Missouri Sheriff's Department, upon and under penalties of perjury, state as follows:
1.	I have probable cause to believe that on 08-26-2017, at 1300 Cherry KCMO 64106 which is inside the boundaries of Jackson County, Missouri, RODGERS, Rodney V., B/M, 05-03-1993, WILLARD, Tyrone E., B/M, 10-05-1996, CURTNER, Stephen A., W/M, 12-19-1996, and SNEED, OSIRIS N., B/M, 07-31-1997, committed one or more criminal offenses.
	Assault
2)	The facts supporting this belief are as follows:
	On August 26 th , 2017 an assault occurred at the jail around 2230 hours in the fifth floor housing unit "J5E," which is a lock down administrative segregation module, involving four inmates identified as RODGERS, WILLARD, CURTNER, and SNEED. The inmates planned and executed an attack on Corrections Office by punching him with closed fists and kicking him. While SNEED, RODGERS, and WILLARD repeatedly struck C/O Inmate, CURTNER did not directly engage in the attack on the C/O but appeared to act as a lookout.
	On August 29 th , 2017, I spoke with C/O

behind inmate SNEED, immediately started to repeatedly hit C/O with closed fists at the same time as inmate SNEED was also striking C/O with closed fists. Inmate WILLARD ran from the bathroom/shower area and proceeds to also strike C/O with closed fists. Inmate CURTNER ran out of the bathroom/shower area with WILLARD but he did not to strike C/O but appeared to be a look out. C/O advised that the inmates punched him multiple times with closed fists and kicked him in the back and side of his head and upper torso. He said he tried to keep his face covered to protect his face. The assault lasted approximately two minutes and C/O advised, he "feared for his life." C/O responsible to North Kansas City Hospital to be checked out approximately three days after the assault due to constant headaches and a sore hand. His medical diagnosis was a neck sprain, head trauma/concussion, and an acute avulsion fracture at the dorsal margin of the base of the fifth distal phalanx, at the insertion of the extensor digitorum tendon. He is required to where a splint on the injured finger. C/O responsible to the hospital on August 30, 2017 for severe abdominal pain with nausea. His medical diagnosis for the emergency room visit on August 30, 2017 was "elevated cr," which indicates the kidneys are not functioning properly possibly caused by trauma for the affected area during the assault on August 26, 2017.
