COMPLAINT

Count I. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt - Serious Physical Injury Or Special Victim (565.050-001Y19841305.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the class A felony of assault in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about November 14, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused serious physical injury to by stabbing, and in the course thereof inflicted serious physical injury on _______.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about November 14, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of assault in the first degree charged in Count One, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant

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committed the foregoing felony of by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a dangerous instrument.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

Count III. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171205.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about November 14, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant forcibly stole a billford in the possession of and in the course thereof defendant used a dangerous instrument against

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count IV. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755212.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about November 14, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count three, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant

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committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a dangerous instrument.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo, as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 11/14/2017 officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were dispatched to Hectors Car Wash, located at 820 Prospect Ave., Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a medical call.

Officers responded and while KCFD EMS was treating the victim, who was unresponsive they observed apparent stab wounds to his abdomen. KCFD EMS transported the victim to an area hospital with life threatening injuries. The victim was not conscious and was unable to provide a statement. Detectives were advised the victim had a life threatening brain bleed resulting from his injuries. Crime Scene personnel responded to the hospital and utilized a fingerprint scanner to identify the victim as

Detectives responded to the crime scene and found video footage of the incident from the Car wash located at 820 Prospect Av and from Express Mart located at 2519 E 9th St. A witness was also located at the scene. The witness advised the suspect was a homeless, white male with a crooked face that he is frequently warning not to trespass on the property. The witness advised that he previously spoke with officers that knew the suspects name.

Officer Allen was contacted and responded to the scene and upon speaking with the witness and viewing the video identified the suspect as **SONNY SCOTT**.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT FORM

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Upon review of the video **SCOTT** is observed repeatedly stabbing the victim (for more than seven minutes) in the head and torso and going through the victim's pockets. **SCOTT** is observed removing the victim's billfold, then when the witness pulls up to the vacuuming station, **SCOTT** leaves on foot southbound.

SCOTT was apprehended at 3701 Truman Road, an unoccupied building and transported to Police Headquarters for questioning. Detectives observed **SCOTT** to have a large amount of apparent blood on his clothing however he did not appear injured. **SCOTT** initially waived his Miranda rights and agreed to provide a statement, then denied any involvement and requested an attorney.

The arresting officers remained at the arrest scene and obtained consent to search from the property owner. Crime Scene personnel responded and located additional clothing of **SCOTT**, and a screwdriver/tool with apparent blood.
