# **COMPLAINT**

## Count I. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171204.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about December 6, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant forcibly stole a 2006 Pontiac G6 in the possession of \_\_\_\_\_\_, and in the course thereof defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

### Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755299.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about December 6, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of robbery in the first degree charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of robbery in the first degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

### **State vs. David A Williams**

THE THOUSE

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

#### PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

Date: 12-6-2017 Report: #2017-87781 I, Steve Schmidli, a Detective with the Independence, Missouri Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herin are true. I have probable cause to believe that on 12-6-2017 at 0126 hours, David A. Williams (Race – B, Sex - M, DOB: 11-26-97, SSN: Last Known Address: 1316 Cleveland, Kansas City MO 64127) Committed one or more criminal offenses in Jackson County, Missouri. 2. The facts supporting this believe are as follows: That on 12-6-2017 at 0126 hours, the Defendant, David A. Williams knowingly and forcibly robbed while being armed with a handgun. During the commission of this offense, the Defendant fired a single shot at which narrowly missed the victim's head but instead struck a juvenile female accomplice in the arm and leg. The Defendant and his juvenile female accomplice stole 2006 silver Pontiac G6 (VIN #1G2ZH57N274186145) and fled the area. This offense occurred at 101 S. Willis in Independence, Jackson County Missouri. P.O. Maggy Chapman is the reporting officer on the offense. She was dispatched on an armed carjacking that just occurred near Maple and Willis. Upon arrival, she contacted the victim, Mr. was briefed on the offense. He advised that he met a white female named " via Snapchat and had responded to 101 S. Willis to met her. He stated that while in his car with the subject. he was robbed at gunpoint by a light skinned black male suspect. During the commission of this offense, the black male suspect fired a single shot at which narrowly missed his head but possibly struck advised that was an accomplice in the robbery. The black male suspect and stole 2006 silver Pontiac G6 (VIN #1G2ZH57N274186145) and fled the area. A single .380 shell casing was located at the crime scene on Willis. P.O. Chapman advised that shortly after responding on the armed carjacking, officers were dispatched to 1113 S. Crescent on a female with a gunshot wound. Upon arrival, officers located unoccupied a block to the west of Truman and Crescent at 9414 E. Truman. Officers then contacted 15 year old juvenile who had sustained a gunshot wound to her arm. Also located at the residence was a light skinned black male that matched the armed carjacking suspect description. This black male subject was identified as David A. Williams. was transported to the address on Crescent and positively identified Mr. Williams as the primary suspect in the robbery. Mr. Williams was taken into custody. was transported to a local hospital for treatment for her gunshot wound. Det. Steve Schmidli conducted a formal interview with advised that he had been communicating with a female named via Snapchat and made an arrangement to meet her for "sex". He advised that he responded to 101 S. Willis in Independence MO and was contacted by n an alley by the residence. He stated that passenger seat of his 2006 silver Pontiac G6 and smoked a cigarette with him. The victim advised that within a few minutes of entering his car, a light skinned black male subject wearing a black bandana over his mouth and neck approached his driver's side door and opened it. The victim stated that the black male subject was armed with a handgun and demanded that he "get out of the car!". The victim stated that the black male suspect pointed the handgun at his head and told him to "empty your pockets!". He advised that he started placing his wallet, cell phone and cigarettes in the driver's seat.
